JOINT RESOLUTIONS BETWEEN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES, CONSOLIDATED FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, AND COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT, VARIOUS COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS, AND OTHER AFFECTED TAXING ENTITIES ACCEPTING THE NEGOTIATED EXCHANGE OF PROPERTY TAX REVENUE AS A RESULT OF PROPOSED ANNEXATIONS TO COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS (ANNEXATION NOS. 14-420, 15-294, 15-295, 21-747, 21-748, 21-749, 21-750, 22-423, 22-424, SCV-1077, SCV-1080, SCV-1082, AND SCV-1083) (FIRST, FOURTH, AND FIFTH DISTRICTS) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

This action is to adopt the Negotiated Property Tax Exchange Joint Resolutions associated with the annexation of territories into Los Angeles County Sanitation Districts Nos. 14, 15, 21, 22, and the Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

Approve Joint Resolutions between the Board, as the governing body of the County, the Consolidated Fire Protection District, and the Los Angeles County Flood Control District, and on behalf of the County Public Library, Road District No. 4, Road District No. 5, Lighting District No. 1687, and Lighting District No. 1744; County Sanitation Districts Nos. 14, 15, 21, 22, and the Santa Clarita Valley Sanitation District (SCV); and other affected taxing entities based on the negotiated exchange of property tax revenue related to proposed Annexation Nos. 14-420 in unincorporated Antelope Valley; 15-294 in unincorporated Hacienda Heights; 15-295 in the City of La Puente; 21-747, 21-749, and 21-750 in unincorporated Claremont; 21-748 in the City of Pomona; 22-423 in the City of San Dimas; 22-424 in the City of La Verne; and SCV-1077, SCV-1080, SCV-1082, and SCV-1083 in the City of Santa Clarita.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The governing bodies of the affected County Sanitation Districts (Districts) and the respective taxing entities have adopted the attached Joint Resolutions based on the negotiated exchange of property tax revenue related to the proposed annexations to the Districts.

In order for the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) for the County of Los Angeles to proceed with the required hearings on the proposed annexations, the Board, as the governing body of the County, Consolidated Fire Protection District, and County Flood Control District, and on behalf of the County Public Library, Road District No. 4, Road District No. 5, Lighting District No. 1687, and Lighting District No. 1744, must also adopt the attached Joint Resolutions.

The proposed annexations involve residential, vacant, and commercial parcels for which there is no other local agency able to provide off site sewage disposal services. The annexations will allow property owners in the affected territories to obtain off site sewage disposal service from the Districts by connecting their properties to existing sewer lines. Currently, the only option available to property owners is to construct private septic systems. In each annexation application submitted to LAFCO, all of the owners of real properties within the affected territories have requested, in writing, that their properties be annexed to the respective County Sanitation Districts.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The Countywide Strategic Plan directs the provision of “Community Support and Responsiveness” (Goal 2) by providing enhanced services, and effectively planning and responding to economic, social, and environmental challenges. The proposed annexations of territories to the Sanitation Districts will enhance services by allowing the property owners in the affected territories to obtain off-site sewage disposal service from the Districts.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There is no base transfer of property taxes associated with these annexations. If the annexations are approved, the adopted joint resolutions will transfer a portion of the annual property tax increment attributable to the annexation areas from the County, Consolidated Fire Protection District, County Flood Control District, and the other affected taxing entities to the affected Districts commencing with the fiscal year after the effective date(s) of the joint resolutions.

The impact of the annexations to the County’s share of incremental property taxes for future years due to the proposed annexations is minimal and is reflected in Attachment A. Annexation No. 15-295 is located in the City of La Puente’s former Redevelopment Project Area (RPA). No transfer of property tax revenues from properties within the RPA, which are deposited into a Redevelopment Property Tax Trust Fund, as created by California Health & Safety Code section 34170.5(b), shall be made during any period that such revenues are required for repayment of Enforceable Obligations as defined by California Health & Safety Code section 34171(d).

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Pursuant to Division 3, Title 5 of the California Government Code, commencing with Section 56000, the affected Districts filed applications with LAFCO to initiate proceedings for annexation of territory to the Districts and adopted the joint resolutions.

Section 99 of the Revenue and Taxation Code (R&T Code) requires that prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change, the governing bodies of all agencies whose service area or service responsibilities will be altered by such change, must negotiate a reallocation of property tax revenue between the affected agencies, and approve and accept such reallocation by resolution. The Districts and the other independent taxing entities have adopted negotiated Joint Resolutions for the subject annexations, as required by Section 99 of the R&T Code. Adoption of the Joint Resolutions by the Board will allow LAFCO to schedule the required public hearings on the proposed annexations. LAFCO will subsequently take action to approve, approve with changes, or disapprove the proposals.

The Joint Resolutions have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

The proposed action is not a project pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) because it is an activity that is excluded from the definition of a project by Section 15378(b) of the State CEQA Guidelines. This proposed action is the creation of a government funding mechanism, a fiscal activity which does not involve any commitment to any specific project which may result in a potentially significant physical impact on the environment.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

No impact on current services.



WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 99 and 99.01 of the Revenue and Taxation Code, prior to the effective date of any jurisdictional change which will result in a special district providing a new service, the governing bodies of all local agencies that receive an apportionment of the property tax from the area must determine the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increment to be exchanged between the affected agencies and approve and accept the negotiated exchange of property tax revenues by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the agencies signatory hereto have made determinations of the amount of property tax revenues from the annual tax increments to be exchanged as a result of the annexation to County Sanitation District No. 14 entitled *Annexation No. 420*;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The negotiated exchange of property tax revenues resulting from the annexation of territory to County Sanitation District No. 14 in the annexation entitled *Annexation No. 420* is approved and accepted.

2. For each fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2015, or after the effective date of this jurisdictional change, whichever is later, the County Auditor shall transfer to County Sanitation District No. 14 a total of 0.0360809 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within *Annexation No. 420* as shown on the attached Worksheet.

No. 14 a total of 0.0360809 percent of the annual tax increment attributable to the land area encompassed within *Annexation No. 420* as shown on the attached Worksheet.

3. No additional transfer of property tax revenues shall be made from any other tax agencies to County Sanitation District No. 14 as a result of annexation entitled *Annexation No. 420*.

4. No transfer of property tax increments from properties within a community redevelopment project, which are legally committed to a Community Redevelopment Agency, shall be made during the period that such tax increment is legally committed for repayment of the redevelopment project costs.

5. If at any time after the effective date of this resolution, the calculations used herein to determine initial property tax transfers or the data used to perform those calculations are found to be incorrect thus producing an improper or inaccurate property tax transfer, the property tax transfer shall be recalculated and the corrected transfer shall be implemented for the next fiscal year, and any amounts of property tax received in excess of that which is proper shall be refunded to the appropriate agency.

The foregoing resolution was on the 2nd day of August, 2016, adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles and ex officio the governing body of all other special assessment and taxing districts, agencies and authorities for which said Board so acts.
