On Monday, April 25, 2016, shortly after 1:00 a.m., Long Beach police officers responded to a hit and run traffic collision in the area of 7th Street and Loma Avenue. When officers arrived, they discovered the body of 27-year-old William Mendoza lying in the road motionless. It is believed that Mr. Mendoza was the victim of a hit and run traffic collision. Paramedics responded and pronounced him deceased at the scene. After reviewing video of the incident, Investigators believe he was struck by a 2005-2009, white, Dodge Charger.

Investigators have canvassed the neighborhood looking for witnesses to the incident and feel they are at a point where it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individual(s) responsible for this crime.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors offer a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s) of this heinous crime.
