On July 11, 2015, Norwalk Station Deputies responded to Gerdes Park located at 14700 Gridley Avenue in the City of Norwalk, regarding a shots fired call. Upon arrival, they discovered 25 year old victim Edwin Morales had been shot and killed while he was at the park playing basketball. Two gang members were seen shooting randomly at the males at the park. Investigators determined victim Morales had no gang affiliation.

Investigators believe it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individual(s) responsible for this crime. They may remain anonymous. As of this date, no additional witnesses have come forward.

I, THEREFORE MOVE that the Board of Supervisors establish a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s) of this heinous crime. They can remain anonymous.
