TERMINATION OF THE COUNTY DELINQUENCY PREVENTION PROGRAM (CDPP) AGREEMENT WITH ALHAMBRA YOUTH BOXING CLUB FOR CONVENIENCE

(SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 5) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

Request approval to terminate the County Delinquency Prevention Program (CDPP) agreement with Alhambra Youth Boxing Club (AYBC) for convenience, and delegate authority to terminate CDPP and Countywide Juvenile Crime and Anti-Gang Strategies Program (Anti-Gang) contracts.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Terminate the CDPP agreement with AYBC, in whole, for convenience.
2. Delegate authority to the Interim Chief Probation Officer to terminate agreements under the CDPP and the Countywide Juvenile Crime and Anti-Gang Strategies Program (Anti-Gang), in whole or in part.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

On October 22, 2015, Probation entered into a CDPP agreement with AYBC. The agreement expires October 21, 2016. Probation recommends that your Board terminate the agreement with AYBC pursuant to Paragraph 8.42 - Termination for Convenience as it has been deemed by Probation it is in the County's best interest. The termination will be effective the day following Board action. In addition, Probation is requesting delegated authority to terminate CDPP and Anti-Gang agreements

for reasons provided in the County's contract language.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

The recommended actions are consistent with the County of Los Angeles Strategic Plan Goal 1, Operational Effectiveness/Fiscal Sustainability.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There is no impact on the County General Fund. Funding allocated to AYBC will be re-appropriated back to the 5th District CBO funds.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The County operated a community-based Delinquency Prevention Program funded under the State's County Justice System Subvention Program (formerly known as the AB 90 program). While the State discontinued funding for this program in July 1990, the agency agreements have been continued by the use of County General Funds.

Since July 1, 1991, the County has had the responsibility of administering the State's Juvenile Delinquency Prevention Program, which is primarily financed by the State's Realignment Funds (formerly known as AB 1491). In FY 1993/1994, both the former AB 90 and former AB 1491 programs were consolidated into what is now called the CDPP.

On July 1, 1997, the County of Los Angeles Probation Department (Probation) implemented the Anti-Gang to reduce the criminal activities of street gangs in Los Angeles County and to restore community safety by implementing local target area program which effectively integrate prevention, intervention, suppression and incarceration strategies through multi-agency coordination and community partnering.

On June 22, 1999, the Board delegated authority to the Chief Probation Officer to: 1) finalize and execute the standardized agreements with community based organizations (CBOs) and local service agencies identified by your Board, 2) execute modifications to standardized agreements not exceeding 10% or 90 days pursuant to the terms in the agreements; and 3) negotiate, finalize, and execute substantially similar agreements each subsequent fiscal year after approval by County Counsel, based on budgeted funding being provided to finance these programs.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Termination of this agreement will have no impact as Probation will continue to enter into agreements with CBOs and local service agencies identified by your Board to provide CDPP and Anti-Gang services.
