At its meeting held March 3, 2004, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“National Weights and Measures Week is being observed during the week of March 1 through 7, 2004, by State and local jurisdictions throughout the United States. This is the recognition of the first Weights and Measures law, passed by the United States Congress on March 2, 1799.

“The County of Los Angeles Department of Agricultural Commissioner/Weights and Measures has chosen the theme for the County’s observance: ‘Accuracy in Recycling – Getting What You Sell For.’ This issue has special significance in Los Angeles County where there are hundreds of recycling centers and where many thousands of County residents practice recycling.

“The Agricultural Commissioner/Weights and Measures Department routinely conducts undercover inspections at recycling facilities. These inspections have uncovered and corrected problems, enhancing the integrity of the recycling process and encouraging more residents to recycle containers.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Burke, unanimously carried, the Board adopted a resolution and proclaimed March 1 through 7, 2004 as "Weights and Measures Week" throughout Los Angeles County.
