EXECUTIVE OFFICER**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE BONITA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT APPROVING THE RESCHEDULING OF BOARD OF EDUCATION MEMBER ELECTIONS FROM ODD TO EVEN YEAR ELECTIONS COMMENCING WITH THE 2018 BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION**

WHEREAS, Education Code Section 5000 and Elections Code section 1302(a) provide for a regular biennial election to elect members to the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Bonita Unified School District (the "District"), to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of odd-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, Elections Code section 1302(b) establishes a procedure whereby the Board may change the election date for its Board members by adopting a resolution seeking approval of the change by the Board of Supervisors of the affected county (Elections Code section 10405.5); and

WHEREAS, if the change in election date is approved, the election date for Board members will be moved from November of odd years to November of even years commencing in 2018, with Board members whose terms would have expired in 2017 being extended to 2018, and Board members whose terms would have expired in 2019 being extended to 2020, as required by Elections Code section 10401.5(g).


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the Bonita Unified School District as follows:

1. The Board adopts this resolution to consolidate the election day for members of the Board with the California general election in November of even years (Elections Code 1001) pursuant to Elections Code section 1302(b).
2. The Superintendent will forward this resolution to the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and request formal approval of the change by the Board of Supervisors at a public meeting within 60 days after submission and after this resolution has been posted by the Board of Supervisors in accordance with law.
3. If the consolidation of election is adopted and submitted to the Board of Supervisors at least 240 days prior to the next scheduled school Board election (Elections Code section 10404.5(a)) and if the Board of Supervisors approves of the consolidation, the date of the District's next Board election will be moved to November 2018 and each subsequent Board member election will be held two years thereafter in November of even years.
4. The District's next regular election to be held on November 2017 shall therefore be held November 2018 upon approval of the Los Angeles Board of Supervisors as provided herein.
5. The District's next subsequent regular election to be held on November 2019 shall therefore be held November 2020 upon approval of the Los Angeles Board of Supervisors as provided herein.
6. If the consolidation of election is approved by the Board of Supervisors, the term of office of current Board members expiring in November 2017 will be extended to November 2018, and the term of Board members expiring in November 2019 will be extended to November 2020.


7. The District Superintendent or designee shall deliver copies of this Resolution to the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, the Los Angeles County Superintendent of Schools and the Los Angeles County Registrar of Voters. The Superintendent or his designee is authorized to take such actions and execute such documentation necessary to affect the intent of this Resolution.


