REWARD EXTENSION – THOMAS GRAY

On June 16, Thomas Gray was the victim of a shooting incident which occurred on the 1600 block of Cactus Drive in Lancaster. A second victim, Jamal Smith, suffered a laceration to his head. Both victims were transported to the Antelope Valley Hospital. Victim Smith was treated for his injuries and released; however, victim Gray succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced dead the following day.

According to victim Smith, his memory is limited to when he opened the front door and was confronted by a person pointing a gun at his head. He also recalls wrestling with the suspect and being hit in the head. He was unable to provide a description of the suspect(s).

Sheriff's Homicide Bureau is seeking the public's help in solving this heinous crime. The \$20,000 reward previously approved by the Board is due to expire on December 26, 2016

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors extend the reward in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person(s) responsible for the heinous murder of Thomas Gray on June 16 on the 1600 block of Cactus Drive in Lancaster.
