## **Establish the Reward Offer in the Murder of Ramiro Lepe**

On Sunday, August 5, 2016, at 9:06 p.m., 39-year-old Ramiro Lepe was shot and ultimately killed while standing outside with family members on the 2600 block of East 129th Street, in the unincorporated area of Willowbrook. At the time of the incident three Hispanic male suspects exited a dark colored, faded 1990's 4-door compact while the driver remained inside. One of the suspects, described as being between the ages of 16-19 years old, shot Mr. Lepe several times with a handgun. The suspects then fled in the vehicle and were last seen heading westbound on 129<sup>th</sup> Street toward Mona Boulevard. Mr. Lepe was transported to Saint Francis Medical Center in the city of Lynwood, where he succumbed to his injuries in the emergency room.

Mr. Lepe was celebrating his birthday on the day of the fatal shooting. What should have been a commemorative day for him and his loved ones turned into a senseless tragedy. He is survived by his wife of 16 years and his four children. Mr. Lepe was the sole provider to the family: he was employed as a driver for a waste disposal company. He is described as a caring and loving father, husband, and friend, and a hardworking man. The untimely death has devastated his family, friends and the community.
