At its meeting held March 23, 2004, the Board took the following action:

At the time and place regularly set, notice having been duly given, the following item was called up:

Hearing to vacate a portion of the alley north of Eagle Street, unincorporated East Los Angeles area (1); and find that the vacation is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

Rafael Machuca, representing the Department of Public Works, was duly sworn and testified. Opportunity was given for interested persons to address the Board. No interested persons addressed the Board.

On motion of Supervisor Yaroslavsky, seconded by Supervisor Molina, unanimously carried, the Board closed the hearing and took the following actions:

1. Made a finding that the proposed vacation is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, and that the vacated area is no longer needed for present or prospective public use, including bicycle paths and trails; and
2. Adopted the attached resolution ordering the vacation and instructed the Director of Public Works to record said resolution with the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
