At its meeting held March 30, 2004, the Board took the following action:

The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Knabe:

“April 2004 marks the 36th anniversary of the enactment of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, Title VIII, (the Act) which guarantees the right to equal housing opportunities; for all persons regardless of race, color, religion and national origin. Amendments of this act have broadened the protections to include gender, families with children, and persons with disabilities.

“The County of Los Angeles represents one of the most diverse jurisdictions in the nation. The Community Development Commission of Los Angeles County supports and promotes fair housing activities in conjunction with the Housing Rights Center and its affiliated fair housing councils. Furthermore, our nation annually celebrates the rights granted under the Act during the month of April.”

Therefore, at the suggestion of Supervisor Knabe and on motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried (Supervisor Knabe being absent), the Board proclaimed April 2004 as "Fair Housing Month" throughout Los Angeles County to recognize the value and importance of the rights guaranteed under the Civil Rights Act of 1968, Title VIII, and its amendments, and to commit to the furtherance of its goals and ideals throughout the year.
