COUNTY FILMING FEES (ITEM NO. 9, AGENDA OF MAY 2, 2017)

On May 2, 2017, the Board of Supervisors (Board) instructed the Chief Executive Officer (CEO), to:

- 1. Examine the CEO Film Liaison's responsibilities and report back in 60 days with recommendations to strengthen its role in facilitating filming and relationships with film production entities;
- Review film and license fees charged by the County and non-profit foundations operating on County-owned property and report back to the Board in 60 days with recommended reductions, in order that Los Angeles County can be competitive with other local jurisdictions; and

The Board further instructed County Counsel to:

3. Coordinate with the Departments of Regional Planning, Parks and Recreation, Public Works, Fire, Sheriff, and any other appropriate County code enforcement department to review and within 60 days, provide recommended amendments to the County Code, as necessary, to ensure that County departments have the necessary enforcement authority to address violations of the film permitting process by property owners and production companies.

This report will address Items 1 and 2. County Counsel will respond in a separate memo regarding Item 3.

CEO Film Liaison Responsibilities

Current Responsibilities

The CEO's office currently contracts with FilmLA, Inc. (FilmLA) for film and still photography permit processing for on-location motion picture, television and commercial production events in the unincorporated areas of the County and on County-owned or leased property. Under the agreement, FilmLA is further responsible for:

- 1. Informing the industry of special conditions related to filming/still photography activities;
- 2. Obtaining approval of all applicable County departments prior to issuance of a permit;
- Collecting all applicable Use Fees and Other Fees charged by and due to the County in connection with filming/still photography activities; and subsequently disbursing the payments to the County for distribution to the appropriate County departments;
- 4. Ensuring proper advance notification of filming/still photography activities to the affected constituents;
- 5. Providing monitoring of filming activities, as necessary;
- 6. Investigating, tracking and resolving complaints; and
- 7. Soliciting input from community members and consulting with filmmakers, elected officials, and authorities from County departments prior to the issuance of permits.

Under the Agreement, the CEO is responsible, as the County Project Manager, for providing direction in the areas related to "County policy, information requirements and procedural requirements."

Currently, the CEO Film Liaison also:

- 1. Responds to Board office inquiries and Board orders related to filming issues.
- 2. Participates in meetings with FilmLA, and County departments regarding policy direction, procedural requirements or information requirements related to filming.

- 3. Conducts a bi-annual meeting with FilmLA, Industry representatives and County departments to discuss film related issues in the unincorporated areas and at County-owned facilities.
- 4. Coordinates with FilmLA to resolve issues with production companies and County departments.

Proposed Responsibilities

The CEO discussed strengthening our role with County departments, FilmLA, the film industry, and the City of Los Angeles and the City of Long Beach Film Offices. Based on these discussions, we are recommending the following:

- 1. Conduct an annual training seminar for relevant staff in all County departments to emphasize the importance of filming to the County.
- 2. Conduct meetings with County departments to discuss film related issues in the unincorporated areas and at County-owned facilities, as necessary.
- 3. Work with County departments to develop written procedures for filming for each department that will be made available to FilmLA and the film industry.
- 4. Include production companies in meetings with FilmLA and County departments regarding policy direction, procedural requirements or information requirements related to filming.
- 5. Request that County departments provide the CEO with updated lists of locations available for filming and still photography.
- 6. Research in coordination with County departments and FilmLA the possibility of creating an interactive mapping program that lists film locations and frequency of filming.

Review of County and Non-Profit Foundation Film and License Fees

The CEO requested that all County departments and non-profit foundations operating on County-owned property provide a list of their current film fees, and their recommendations on potential fee reductions (Attachments I and II).

Overall, County departments have noted that the fees that they charge are for cost recovery that would otherwise need to be absorbed by the General Fund. The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs has recommended a reduction in the use fee

for their parking lots from \$780 to \$500 per day. Based on the input we have received from the Industry, our focus is to work with FilmLA on a positive approach to resolving issues for production companies, and we do not recommend reducing fees below their current levels, which is based solely on cost recovery.

The non-profit foundations responded that the fees they collect are in line with similar cultural and iconic venues. The LAC+USC Medical Center Foundation is reviewing their facility use fees with County Counsel.
