The Regional Planning Com	mission erred by impos	sing conditions of approval, which are unlawful and violate both	
federal and state constitution	al standards. Chiquita	Canyon Landfill LLC objects to conditions that do not meet	
constitutional requirements t	hat there be an essent	ial nexus, and rough proportionality, between conditions	
imposed on a project and im	pacts created by a pro	ject. As a result, these conditions result in an unconstitutional	
taking without just compensa	ation of our property. S	everal conditions also do not meet the requirements of California's	
Mitigation Fee Act that there	be a reasonable relati	onship between conditions and project impacts. Also, some	
fees violate the provision of t	he Integrated Waste N	Management Act prohibiting waste limitations based on waste origin.	
We also object to conditions	that impose onerous r	estrictions on the design parameters and operations of the landfill.	
Specifically, we appeal the fo	71	rr; 18; 21; 25-27; 32-34; 36-42; 44; 46; 52; 59; 61; 66; 67; 68; 70; 73-75; 77; 81; 83; 89; 94; 104; 106; 107; 112-122; and Parts I-VII, I, XIV, and XVI of the Implementation and Monitoring Plan.
