We plan to grow our humanitarian services as more partners and resources are gathered.

Our long term business plans for JDFC VETERANS AFFAIRS is to secure, rent and maintain VETERANS HOUSING FACILITIES by securing grants and corporate funding to house and maintain facilities & offices for Veterans support, adding partnerships with Veterans Organizations and Community Groups. We plan to grow our awareness programs and PTSD PETITION for legislative actions helping all Veterans in-need.

Our organization has been in existence for over seven years providing clothing as well as meals to the homeless. Our organization understands that sometimes it is very hard to maintain a stable state of mind with economic struggles but nobody deserves to starve. Holiday's are the most difficult for times for the homeless. Our company participated in Pasadena's ten year strategy to end homelessness to formulate a plan for the community. By the year 2011 our company is looking forward to meeting some very important goals such as housing for homeless, meal vouchers, clothing vouchers, and counseling for the homeless.

James Jacobs had a vision to help homeless people so he came up with a plan. He started collecting donations to fund food, clothing, and motel rooms for the homeless. He started out in the Pasadena area and the LAX area. For two years he was the company's first fundraiser volunteer. After collecting enough donations the very first event took place Thanksgiving of 2002. The company was able to feed a total of thirty five people. After the dinner James witnessed a swamp of calls for volunteers. These volunteers helped raise money for the corporation, and participated in events that the company held. Several of the companies fundraisers come from a professional background and found the volunteer position as a big help and a life changing move. Since the launch of the company over four hundred people have passed through the company and are doing much better than they were in intake. The company has been able to feed the homeless during every holiday, and maintain a twenty four hour prayer kitchen with David Futch in Los Angeles, Ca that feeds the homeless and gives clothing to those who are in need daily, and run a recovery home. The holidays that the company was able to feed were Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. Over the years the company has fed over twenty thousand people. The company has also held other events such as Horse Riding, Surf Day, and a Christmas Giveaway. There are three events remaining for the year Labor Day Dinner, Thanksgiving Dinner, and Christmas Dinner. Though the company has not opened a shelter they have been able to house families and individuals in Motel rooms. The company has been able to help a multitude of out-of-towners who got stuck in California. The company has vastly grown over the last seven years, and looks forward to much more growth in the years to come.
