LAKEWOOD GOLF COURSE IMPROVEMENTS AND CART BARN REPLACEMENT PROJECT APPROVE REVISED PROJECT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ADJUSTMENT CAPITAL PROJECT NO. 87324 (SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 4) (4 VOTES)

SUBJECT

Approval of the recommended actions will approve the revised project budget and appropriation adjustment for the Lakewood Golf Course Improvements and Cart Barn Replacement Project, Capital Project No. 87324, to allow the Department of Parks and Recreation to complete the capital project.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

- 1. Find that the recommended actions of revising the previously approved Project's budget and appropriating funds are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act.
- 2. Approve the revised total project budget of \$7,586,000, from a previously adopted budget of \$6,589,000 to address unforeseen conditions for the Lakewood Golf Course Improvements and Cart Barn Replacement Project, Capital Project No. 87324.
- 3. Approve the attached appropriation adjustment to appropriate \$997,000 using Lakewood Golf Course Capital Improvement Project funds, available in the Department's Golf Course Fund (CA2), to Capital Assets Buildings and Improvements under Capital Project No. 87324 to fully fund the Capital Project.

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PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The recommended actions will approve the revised budget, which will allow the Department of Parks and Recreation (Department) to complete the previously approved Lakewood Golf Course Improvements and Cart Barn Replacement Project (Project) at 3101 Carson Street, Lakewood, CA 90712.

On March 22, 2016, the Board approved the Project budget in the amount of \$6,589,000 to implement the Project in two phases. Phase 1 includes removal and replacement of the existing cart barn with a new structure containing a mechanical repair and washing area, offices, and a conference room; complete renovation of the entry plaza, including a new drop-off area, cart staging area, restrooms in the existing pro shop, and range entry; parking lot refurbishment with an emphasis on accessibility; and the renovation of the driving range, including the tee line, shade structure, range targets, electrical upgrades, and Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility upgrades. Phase 2 includes the renovation and expansion of the coffee shop, bar, banquet room, offices, and patio area; restroom upgrades; building flooring, finish, electrical, and lighting upgrades; and ADA accessibility upgrades.

The increase in the Project budget of \$997,000 resulted from costs to address unforeseen conditions that emerged during construction, including discovery of an underground storage tank for gasoline and rotted wood throughout club house. In addition, electrical upgrades were required since the existing system could not support the temporary electric golf cart facility which was needed to maintain operation during construction. Above average rainfall also delayed construction and contributed to increased costs.

In March of 2016 the Board was informed that the Department would utilize available Lakewood Golf Course Capital Improvement Project (CIP) funds for the costs that exceeded the previously approved Project budget. The Lakewood Golf Course CIP Fund is funded from a percentage of the gross green fees revenues generated at the Lakewood Golf Course. In accordance with the terms of the operating lease agreement, the CIP funds provide for capital and infrastructure improvements to maintain the Lakewood Golf Course in a competitive condition.

<u>Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals</u>

The Countywide Strategic Plan directs the provisions of Making Investments That Transform Lives (Goal 1), Fostering Vibrant and Resilient Communities (Goal 2), and Realizing Tomorrow's Government Today (Goal 3). These recommended actions support the Strategic Plan by investing in public infrastructure that will improve services for County of Los Angeles residents.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

On March 22, 2016, the Board approved a total Project budget of \$6,589,000. The revised total Project Budget is currently estimated at \$7,586,000, which consists of a revised construction cost of \$6,322,000 and a contingency fund of \$1,264,000

Approval of the attached appropriation adjustment (Attachment II) will appropriate \$997,000 of CIP funds from the Department's Golf Course Fund (CA2) to Capital Assets – Buildings and Improvements under Capital Project No. 87324 to fully fund the Project. The revised total Project Budget of \$7,586,000 will be funded by \$6,589,000 of net County Cost from the Fourth District and \$997,000 using Lakewood Golf Course CIP funds. The revised Project Schedule and Budget Summary are included in Attachment I.

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There will be no impact to net County cost as a result of the recommendations.

Operating Budget Impact

There will be no operating budget impact. The Lease Agreement requires American Golf Corporation to operate and maintain the Lakewood Golf Course.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Amendment No. 7 to the County Operating Lease Agreement No. 67269 with American Golf Corporation, the operator of the Lakewood Golf Course, was approved by the Board on March 22, 2016 to address the implementation and funding of the Project.

As previously approved by your Board on March 22, 2016, and in accordance with the Board's Civic Art Policy adopted December 7, 2004, and last revised on August 11, 2015, the proposed Project is exempt from the policy because it is a commercial project.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

On March 22, 2016, the Board found the Lakewood Golf Course Improvements and Cart Barn Replacement Project to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). Additional work to address the unforeseen conditions during construction was subsequently completed. The recommended actions of revising the budget and appropriating funds are not a project pursuant to Section 21065 of the Public Resources Code and Section 15378(b)(5) of the State CEQA Guidelines because the actions are administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect changes to the environment.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

Under the terms of the Amendment, American Golf Corporation will provide all services required for the successful completion of the Project, including construction plans and specifications, obtaining all required permits, inspections and approvals, soliciting a minimum of three bids, contracting for the actual construction of the proposed Project, enforcing contract requirements related to licensing and bonding, completion of as-built drawings, and proper close-out of the contract. All contractors providing labor for the Project will be required to pay not less than the specified general prevailing wage rates as established by the state of California. In addition, the Amendment provides that the Department must approve the plans and specifications for the proposed Project and the Department's Golf Operations Section will oversee its construction and approve all payment applications submitted by American Golf Corporation.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

The golf course will remain open during the construction and implementation of the proposed Project.
