ANALYSIS

This ordinance: (1) amends the proprietary petroleum pipeline franchise granted by Ordinance No. 92-0090F to Standard Gas Company, an Idaho corporation, to reflect the consent of the Board of Supervisors to a change of control of the franchise rights from Standard Gas Company to Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation; (2) extends the term of the franchise through December 31, 2022; (3) imposes additional safety and reporting requirements pertaining to inactive, static, abandoned, idle, and out-of-service pipelines; and (4) makes other minor revisions to clarify certain terms and conditions of the franchise.

An ordinance amending the proprietary petroleum pipeline franchise granted by Ordinance No. 92-0090F to Standard Gas Company.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 92-0090F is hereby amended to read as follows:

The right, privilege and franchise is granted to Standard Gas Section 1. Company, Chevron U.S.A. Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation ("Franchisee"), and its successors and assigns, to lay or construct from time to time and for the period of twenty-five (25) yearsthrough December 31, 2022, to lay, construct, reconstruct, maintain, operate, renew, repair, change the size of, and remove or abandon in place. pipes and pipelines for the collection, transportation or distribution of oil, petroleum, gas, gasoline, other hydrocarbon substances, wet gas, industrial gas, chemicals, mud, steam, water, waste water, and other liquid substances, exceptexcluding any hazardous substances or hazardous waste within the meaning of the "Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation and Liability Act of 1980", 42 U.S.C. 9601 et seq., as amended, and as it may hereafter be amended, the "Federal Pollution-Water Pollution Control Act", 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq., as amended, and as it may hereafter be amended, and the "Solid Waste Disposal Act", 42 U.S.C. 6901 et seq., as amended, and as it may hereafter be amended, together with all manholes, valves, cathodic protection systems, appurtenances and service-connections necessary or convenientappropriate for the operation of said pipes or pipelines, including poles,

conduits, wires, cables and other appurtenances and equipment for telegraph or telephone lines or both, necessary or convenient appropriate for the Franchisee's business, in, under, along or across any and all highways (as defined in Section 16.36.080 of the Los Angeles County Code), now or hereafter dedicated to public use within the following described service franchise area or areas within the unincorporated territory of the County of Los Angeles ("County"), State of California:

Part A. East Los Angeles aArea:

Beginning at the intersection of Ditman Avenue and the center line of Medford Street; thence southerly along Ditman Avenue to the southerly boundary line of Fowler Street.

Part B. West Los Angeles aArea:

Beginning at the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard and the southerly boundary line of Ohio Avenue; thence northwesterly along Sepulveda Boulevard to the intersection of the center line of Cashmere Street.

Part C. La Mirada a<u>A</u>rea:

Beginning at the intersection of Santa Gertrudes Avenue and the center line of Leffingwell Road; thence southerly along Santa Gertrudes Avenue to the intersection of the southerly boundary line of Lemon Drive/Ocean Avenue.

Part D. Carson Area:

Beginning at the intersection of Del Amo Boulevard and the easterly boundary line of Alameda Street; thence westerly along Del Amo Boulevard to the intersection of the center line of Wilmington Avenue.

Part E. Harbor Corridor aArea:

Beginning at the intersection of Del Amo Boulevard and the Harbor Freeway; thence westerly along Del Amo Boulevard to the westerly boundary line of Vermont Avenue.

SECTION 2. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 92-0090F is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3. The Franchisee shall:

. . .

D. On or before October 10, 2018, provide evidence satisfactory to the County that all of Franchisee's static, abandoned, idle, inactive, and out-of-service pipelines have been inspected and integrity tested for active use, or approved for removal or abandonment in place, in compliance with applicable federal, State, and local pipeline laws and regulations, including as may be required by the Road Commissioner under the Los Angeles County Code, or the County may terminate the franchise in its sole discretion.

E. On or before October 10, 2018, prepare and implement testing procedures for all pipelines described in subsection D. above, subject to approval by the County, and have the testing and verification of all such pipelines completed by an independent third-party testing company approved by the County, and with oversight by the appropriate agencies, to ensure compliance with all applicable federal, State, and local pipeline laws and regulations throughout the term of the franchise.

SECTION 3. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 92-0090F is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 11. The effective operative date of this franchise shall be August 30, 19922017.




