On July 27, 2013, at 1:19 a.m., a murder occurred in the parking lot of 11688 South Street, Artesia. Five members of the Asian Boys gang confronted the victims and shot one of them. The victim was transported to Long Beach Memorial Hospital where he was pronounced dead. Boren Lay was armed with a large caliber revolver and was identified by witnesses as the gunman. Lay is a member of the gang and frequents the City of Long Beach and surrounding areas.

Detectives feel it would be beneficial to extend the reward; which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information as to the whereabouts of Boren Lay.

On June 4, 2014, this Board approved a \$10,000 reward offer which was extended on August 26, 2014, February 24, 2015, January 24, 2017 and April 11, 2017. The reward is due to expire on October 20, 2017, unless it is extended.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors extend the \$10,000 reward offered in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of Boren Lay in connection with a fatal shooting located in the parking lot of 11688 South Street in the City of Artesia on July 27, 2013.
