ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN DISASTER ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS (ALL AFFECTED DISTRICTS) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

Board approval is requested to take administrative action and designate an Authorized Agent to request disaster assistance funds from the federal and State governments.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

Adopt the Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies which authorizes the Chief Executive Officer, or his/her designee, to apply for and seek reimbursement of disaster assistance funds from the federal and State governments.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The last formal action on the part of your Board to designate Authorized Agents for the purposes of executing applications and other documents pertaining to federal and State disaster assistance programs was made on December 16, 2014. The Applicant's Agent Resolution (Resolution) adopted on that day is currently in good standing but will expire on December 16, 2017. To ensure the County of Los Angeles (County) is allowed to seamlessly continue its participation in disaster assistance programs, a renewed Resolution is required to be adopted prior to the expiration of the current designation Resolution.

<u>Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals</u>

Access to this grant funding addresses the following County Strategic Plan Goals and Strategies: Goal II.2 – Support the Wellness of our Communities; Goal III.1 – Continually Pursue Development

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of Our Workforce; and Goal III.3 – Pursue Operational Effectiveness, Fiscal Responsibility, and Accountability.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

This action on the part of the Board will allow the County to continue to participate fully in past, present, and future federal and State disaster assistance programs. The County has been participating in 12 open, declared disaster events and seven Fire Management Assistance Grants since the approval of the current designation Resolution.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) have provided the County with specific guidelines for the management and administration of disaster assistance programs that detail the activities and expenditures that are allowable under their respective programs established by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988 and the California Disaster Assistance Act.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Approval of the renewing designation Resolution will allow the County to continue to seek reimbursement for eligible disaster-related expenditures under the FEMA and Cal OES disaster assistance programs.
