Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“Last week, a high-risk sex offender was released from prison and moved to Lancaster near his mother’s Antelope Valley home. A newspaper article also states the mother is a foster parent. Although the convicted sex offender is not allowed near the mother’s home as a condition of his parole, the community is concerned regarding the safety of the foster children residing in the home.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried, the Director of Children and Family Services was directed to report back in three days regarding the high-risk sex offender who was released from prison and moved to Lancaster near his mother's Antelope Valley home and what steps were taken to ensure the safety of the foster children residing in the mother's home.
