

RESOLUTION NO. 2404

A RESOLUTION OF THE ALTADENA LIBRARY DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES PROVIDE FOR A SPECIAL TAX ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE ALTADENA LIBRARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, The Altadena Library District is within the service area of the County of Los Angeles , and provides library services and facilities to the residents of Altadena; and

WHEREAS, the Altadena Library District Board of Trustees recognizes that it is necessary and desirable that the Altadena Library District (the "District") levy a special tax against parcels within the Altadena Library District to provide adequate funding for library services and facilities to the residents of the Altadena Library District; and

WHEREAS, the revenue collected by the special tax will be used to fund library services and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles has scheduled a general election to be held on November 2, 2004, which election will be conducted by the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of the Altadena Library District:

Section 1. Finds that the public health, safety, and economic welfare of the District will be promoted by participating in the special tax levy and that the territory of the District will benefit from the proposed library services and facilities.

Section 2. Requests that the County submit to the qualified voters with the District, at the general election to be held in the County on November 2, 2004, the question of a special tax to be levied by the County against parcels within the District in the amount of \$40.63 per single family residence parcel; \$27.85 per apartment unit, \$82.38 per commercial parcel of less than 10,000 square feet, and \$111.39 per commercial parcel of 10,000 square feet or more. The first through the tenth year in which the special tax is levied will be indexed to the Los Angeles, Anaheim, Riverside All Urban Consumer Price Index, or any successor index, during the twelve months which end on March 1<sup>st</sup> preceding each fiscal year. The special tax shall be increased or decreased each year after the first year by the percentage change in the aforementioned consumer price index.

Section 3. Requests that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles issue instructions to the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk to take any and all steps necessary for the submission of the question of the special tax to the qualified voters within the District at the November 2, 2004 election.

Section 4. Recognizing that additional costs will be incurred by the county by reason of this election, the District agrees to reimburse the County for those additional costs.

Section 5. Directs the City Clerk to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk.
