Create a County Interim Housing Capital Funding Pool

Interim housing plays a pivotal role in the work to combat homelessness across Los Angeles County. Although the County's ultimate goal is to move families and individuals facing homelessness into permanent housing, interim housing serves a very important function for many families and individuals on the path to permanent housing, especially individuals who have significant clinical needs.

LAHSA's 2018 Housing Gaps Analysis identified a need for 3,250 additional interim housing beds and, on May 15, 2018, the Board approved Measure H funding for the operation of this number of additional interim housing beds. Some of these additional beds will not require capital funding from the County and previously-approved Measure H capital funding for interim housing will support over 500 new beds. Additional capital funding is needed, however, to bring on a portion of these new beds, particularly for strategic projects and projects in difficult to serve regions of the County.

WE, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Chief Executive Officer to report back during 2018-19 Supplemental Budget with a plan to create an Interim Housing Capital Funding Pool with clearly identified sources of funds
