At its meeting held June 8, 2004, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“The red, white, and blue star spangled banner symbolizes and represents all that is good in the United States of America, now more so than ever in this post September 11th world. Since it was adopted by the Continental Congress June 14, 1777, the flag has been proudly flown over homes, offices, government buildings and battlefields. National Flag Week was created June 9, 1966, by the 89th Congress of the United States authorizing the President to declare the week in which Flag Day, June 14 occurs as National Flag Week, and the twenty-one day period ending on July 4th as a special time during which the flag should be displayed. This year National Flag Week will be held from June 13 through June 19, 2004, across the country.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Burke, unanimously carried, the Board proclaimed June 13 through 19, 2004 as "National Flag Week," throughout Los Angeles County; and encouraged all citizens of the County to proudly display their flags.
