Proclaim October 5th Energy Efficiency Day

Energy Efficiency Day is a national day to spread awareness about the benefits of energy efficiency which is the practice of obtaining the same or better performance using less energy. Energy efficiency helps to lower customer bills, reduces air and climate pollution, and creates jobs – more than 2.2 million Americans are currently employed in energy efficiency-related occupations. A growing number of governments and organizations have proclaimed October 5th Energy Efficiency Day to raise awareness of the importance of energy efficiency and to encourage individuals, households, businesses, and institutions to become more energy efficient.

Energy efficiency is also vital to achieving Los Angeles County’s sustainability goals and to building a more environmentally and economically prosperous region. The 2015 Community Climate Action Plan identified energy efficiency as a key strategy to reduce the County’s greenhouse gas emissions, and the Chief Sustainability Office will be including new energy efficiency approaches as it updates the Climate Action Plan as part of the Countywide Sustainability Plan development process.
