**32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Productivity and Quality Awards Recognition**

The Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors, Chief Executive Office, and the Quality and Productivity Commission will jointly present the 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Productivity and Quality Awards (PQA), with the theme “*Innovating for Impact*,” on Wednesday, October 10, 2018, in the Grand Hall of the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion, Music Center.

The Board congratulates County employees, including the numerous project managers and department heads, for their ongoing achievements in improving quality and productivity, generating savings, implementing and/or improving County services, and establishing beneficial collaborations between departments, the private sector, and the community-at-large.

In addition, the 66 PQA projects submitted this year will provide annual estimated benefits to the County in excess of \$145 million dollars.

3. Waive parking fees in the amount of \$4,000, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for approximately 200 vehicles at the Music Center garage for those attending the 32<sup>nd</sup> Annual Productivity and Quality Awards Program on October 10, 2018; and
4. Request that the Internal Services Department provide the necessary support for activities related to the Board presentation on October 16, 2018; and
5. Request the Executive Officer of the Board to schedule the annual recognition of the PQA Top 10 award winners and QPC Chair Leadership awardee for the weekly meeting of the Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, October 16, 2018; and
6. Waive parking fees in the amount of \$800, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for approximately 40 vehicles at the Music Center garage for PQA Top10 awardees attending the October 16, 2018, board ceremony.

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
