Reward Offer in the Investigation of Murder Victim Jacquarius Quinn

On Sunday, November 6, 2016, at approximately 8:30 p.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department (LASD) deputies were dispatched to the 2300 block of Old Harold Road in the City of Palmdale. 17-year-old Jacquarius "Jay" Quinn was found lying on the middle of the roadway, unconscious and suffering from a gunshot wound to his upper torso. Victim Quinn was transported to an area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

During the investigation, LASD investigators learned that Victim Quinn had returned home after dining out with his family, and was subsequently found on the roadway by witnesses who stopped and called for aid.

At the time of his murder, Victim Quinn was an 11th grade student at R. Rex Parris High School in the City of Palmdale. Victim Quinn is survived by his parents, siblings and grandmother. The families, who have been helpful during the investigation and remain in contact with the investigators, are devastated by this senseless tragedy.

To date, LASD investigators have received no viable clues regarding this murder. I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors establish a \$10,000 reward offer in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for the murder of Jacquarius Quinn.
