Los Angeles County Claims Board's recommendation: Authorize settlement of the matters entitled <u>Janet Moyer</u>, et al. v. County of Los Angeles, et al., United States District Court Case No. 16-CV-09420 in the amount of \$485,000 and instruct the Auditor-Controller to draw a warrant to implement this settlement from the Sheriff's Department and the Department of Health Services' budget.

This lawsuit alleges federal civil rights violations, wrongful death, and negligence arising out of the death of a mentally ill inmate while in the custody of the Sheriff's Department.

On April 28, 2016, Douglas Brown-Palamara was arrested and brought under Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department's custody. On April 29, 2016, he was seen by a mental health clinician and placed in Moderate Observation Housing. On May 3, 2016, he was evaluated by another mental health clinician where he denied any suicidal thoughts. On May 8, 2016, Mr. Palamara committed suicide.

Mr. Palamara's family filed a federal lawsuit against the County of Los Angeles and several County employees alleging that they failed to provide the necessary care to Mr. Brown-Palamara.
