Ensuring Collection of Full Racial and Ethnic Data of COVID-19 Patients Throughout Los Angeles County

WE, THEREFORE MOVE, that the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors instruct the Department of Public Health to <u>immediately take efforts to collect relevant demographic data</u>, including race and ethnicity, across all testing sites and to the Board in writing within 30 7 (seven) days on the following:

- 1. An analysis of available racial and ethnic demographic data on COVID-19 cases, including a breakdown by age groups and socioeconomic status.
- 2. An analysis on COVID-19 testing data to include information on all individuals who have <u>requested testing on the online COVID-19 testing portal and 211 regardless of their ultimate approval for testing, made appointments, received testing, and tested positive <u>or negative</u> by race and ethnicity when available and socioeconomic status, including an analysis of fatalities by race and ethnicity, <u>and provide updates on a weekly basis</u>.</u>
- 3. All testing, data collection, and research efforts underway or planned by the Department of Public Health Center for Health Equity as it relates to COVID-19, including serological testing, and those efforts in partnership with academic institutions and community-based organizations, to ensure prioritization and contextualization of health equity.
