SUMMARY

This is a recommendation to settle for \$199,000, the wrongful death lawsuit brought by Moon Ja Oh (wife), Jung Hoon Oh (son), Jung Eun Oh (daughter), and Eun Ju Han (daughter) for the death of Sun Yook Oh subsequent to his discharge from High Desert Hospital on September 4, 2001. The State, having paid \$40,770.59 for the provision of Medi-Cal care, has a claim for reimbursement, which will be settled by the County.

LEGAL PRINCIPLES

The County is liable for the failure of its hospital and medical staff to provide services consistent with the appropriate standard of care for the circumstances encountered.

SUMMARY OF FACTS

On July 20, 2001, Sun Yook Oh, a 60-year-old man, was admitted to High Desert Hospital for treatment of an inflammation of the lungs due to an infection caused by a mycobacterium (tuberculosis [TB]).

On July 24, 2001, a diagnostic imaging procedure utilizing sound frequency (ultrasound) of Mr. Oh's abdomen indicated an abnormal mass of tissue on his liver. Although an imaging study generated by computer synthesis of x-ray data (CT scan) confirmed the abnormal mass of tissue, medical personnel were unable to determine whether the abnormal mass was a benign tumor consisting of a mass of blood vessels (hemangioma) or a cancerous growth (neoplasm), and recommended that a small piece of tissue be removed from the abnormal mass for diagnostic examination (biopsy).

On August 30, 2001, Mr. Oh underwent a surgical procedure to remove his gallbladder (cholecystectomy) by a procedure utilizing a tube and optical system inserted through a small incision (laparoscopy), which was performed successfully. During this procedure, medical personnel intended to biopsy the abnormal mass found on Mr. Oh's liver. However, after visually inspecting the abnormal mass on the liver, medical personnel concluded that the abnormal mass was most probably an hemangioma, and not a cancerous neoplasm. Due to a risk of severe bleeding that a biopsy of an hemangioma might produce, a complication which High Desert Hospital was not equipped to treat, a decision was made not to perform a biopsy of the abnormal mass of liver tissue.

On September 4, 2001, Sun Yook Oh was discharged. However, medical personnel failed to schedule follow-up diagnostic studies to confirm that the abnormal mass of tissue identified on Mr. Oh's liver as an hemangioma was not a cancerous neoplasm.

On September 3, 2002, Sun Yook Oh was admitted to Olive View/UCLA Medical Center with complaints of abdominal pain, and a yellowish coloring of the skin tissue (jaundice). On September 9, 2002, Mr. Oh underwent a surgical procedure to biopsy the abnormal mass of tissue on his liver. The results of the biopsy indicated that the abnormal liver mass was a cancerous neoplasm. On September 13, 2002, Mr. Oh was discharged.

Although Mr. Oh underwent treatment for cancer, his condition continued to deteriorate. On January 1, 2003, he died of complications associated with his cancer.

DAMAGES

If this matter proceeds to trial, the claimants will likely seek the following:

STATUS OF CASE

The current trial date has been vacated pending approval of this settlement.

Expenses incurred by the County of Los Angeles in the defense of this case through August 18, 2004, are attorneys fees of \$28,638 and \$7,999 in costs.

The total cost to the County of Los Angeles, as a result of this settlement, is as follows:

EVALUATION

Medical experts will be critical of the failure of medical personnel to schedule follow-up diagnostic studies after September 4, 2001, to confirm that the abnormal mass of tissue identified on Mr. Oh's liver as an hemangioma was not a cancerous neoplasm. This failure fell below the standard of care, and is directly responsible for the results observed here.

We join with our private counsel, The Law Offices of Michael Thomas, and our claims administrator, Octagon Risk Services, Inc., in recommending settlement in the amount of \$199,000, and payment of the Medi-Cal lien in the amount of \$40,770.59.

The Department of Health Services concurs in this settlement.
