## AMENDMENT TO ITEM 7- CAPPING FEES FOR THIRD-PARTY DELIVERY SERVICE PLATFORMS IN UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES

As stated, third-party delivery companies have experienced a surge in demand during the COVID-19 pandemic due to the Safer at Home public health orders.

Countywide, food establishments have been relying on these third-party delivery platforms and must accept the steep fees that they charge or risk closing due to lack of business.

I, THEREFORE MOVE, that the Board of Supervisors instruct the relevant County departments to report back to the Board prior to the July 7, 2020 Board meeting with draft ordinance language to cap fees for third-party delivery platforms charged to food establishments located in unincorporated and incorporated communities, in addition to directives, 1-7.
