

MOTION BY SUPERVISOR MICHAEL D. ANTONOVICH

OCTOBER 26, 2004

The County of Los Angeles covers nearly 4,100 square miles, and the Board represents over 10 million residents in 88 cities and 134 unincorporated communities.

To ensure that all citizens have access to their elected representatives, the Board of Supervisors should conduct a Board Meeting each month in a different Supervisorial District. County residents unable to travel downtown on Tuesdays to participate in Board meetings must be afforded the opportunity to have input in the decisions the Board makes on a regular basis – decisions directly impacting the quality of their lives.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Executive Officer of the Board to schedule all Board Meetings falling on the fourth Tuesday of the month to be conducted in a different Supervisorial District, beginning with the Fifth District.
