Engaging Local Health Experts on County COVID-19 Response

Since the beginning of this pandemic, the Board of Supervisors has prioritized consulting experts regarding COVID-19 to ensure the safest and most effective response in Los Angeles County. The Board immediately chartered the Department of Public Health to lead the immediate response, while relying on the Department of Health Services to provide efficient and effective testing and care.
