**APPROVAL OF AMENDMENTS FOR RADIATION THERAPY SERVICES AND
PACEMAKER SURVEILLANCE SERVICES**
(All Districts) (3 Votes)

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

1. Approve and instruct the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to execute Amendment No. 8 to Agreement No. H-204892, substantially similar to Exhibit I, with University of Southern California School of Medicine (USC) for the provision of pacemaker surveillance services, for a maximum obligation not to exceed \$117,000 net County cost, effective December 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, with delegated authority to the Director to extend for six months through June 30, 2006, for a maximum obligation not to exceed \$54,000 for the six-month period, net County cost.
2. Approve and instruct the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to execute Amendment No. 4 to Agreement No. H-210760, substantially similar to Exhibit II, with Valley Radiotherapy Association Medical Group (Valley Radiotherapy) to extend the Agreement effective December 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, with delegated authority to the Director to extend for six months through June 30, 2006, and add Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes, for a maximum obligation not to exceed \$415,000 for the 13-month period and \$208,000 for the six-month period, net County cost.
3. Approve and instruct the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to execute Amendment No. 4 to Agreement No. H-210759, substantially similar to Exhibit III, with Western Tumor Medical Group, Inc. (Western Tumor) to extend the Agreement effective December 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, with delegated authority to the Director to extend for six months through June 30, 2006, and add CPT codes, for a maximum obligation not to exceed \$154,000 for the 13-month period and \$77,000 for the six-month period, net County cost.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:

In approving the recommended actions, the Board is authorizing the Director of Health Services, or his designee, to extend the term of these Agreements to continue the provision of pacemaker surveillance services at LAC+USC Medical Center (LAC+USC) and the provision of as-needed radiation therapy services at Olive View-UCLA Medical Center (Olive View).

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The total projected cost for the entire term of the extension periods, December 1, 2004 through June 30, 2006, for the three Agreements is \$1,025,000 net County cost. For the Agreement with USC, the projected cost for the 13-month period is \$117,000, and for the six-month period the projected cost is \$54,000.

For the 13-month period for the Agreement with Valley Radiotherapy, the projected cost is \$415,000, and for the six-month extension period, the cost will be \$208,000. For the 13-month period for the Agreement with Western Tumor, the projected cost is \$154,000 and for the six-month period the projected cost is \$77,000.

Funding is included in the Fiscal Year 2004-05 Adopted Budget, and will be requested in future fiscal years.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS:

Pacemaker Surveillance Services

Since 1981, the County has contracted with USC for the provision of pacemaker surveillance services at LAC+USC. USC provides a range of heart pacemaker services, including monthly telephonic testing of patients who received pacemakers at LAC+USC, and in-hospital pacemaker monitoring and analysis of pacemaker activity in patients with complications.

On June 25, 1995, the Board approved an Agreement with USC for the provision of pacemaker surveillance services from July 1, 1995 through June 30, 1997. On subsequent occasions, the Board has approved Amendments to extend the Agreement through November 30, 2004.

Radiation Therapy Services

A Letter of Interest was issued in July 1988 to various providers of radiation therapy services in the San Fernando Valley area because Olive View did not have the staff or the equipment to provide inpatient radiation therapy services. Subsequently, on November 27, 1990, the Board approved Agreements with Valley Radiotherapy and Western Tumor. On subsequent occasions, the Board has approved Amendments to extend them through November 30, 2004.

The Amendments (Exhibits II and III) will become effective on December 1, 2004 and continue in full force and effect through December 31, 2005, pending the successful completion of a solicitation process for radiation therapy. The new CPT Codes to be included in this amendment are used for Intensity Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT) which is a treatment modality for certain cancers. All orders referred for IMRT require the review and approval of the facility Medical Director.

The Amendments update the Agreements to include all required standard provisions including revised language for Contractor Responsibility and Debarment, and the Child Support Compliance Program.

The Department has determined that the Agreements are not Prop. A agreements and therefore the provision of the County's Living Wage Ordinance Program does not apply.

The Amendments (Exhibits I, II and III) have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

CONTRACTING PROCESS:

It is not appropriate to advertise amendments to agreements on the Los Angeles County Online Web Site as a business opportunity.


The Department will conduct a Letter of Interest for pacemaker surveillance services for LAC+USC and a competitive bid for radiation therapy services for Olive View in 2005.

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

PACEMAKER SURVEILLANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT

UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA

Amendment No. 8

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____,
2004,

by and between COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES (hereafter
"County"),

and UNIVERSITY OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA
(hereafter "Contractor").

WHEREAS, reference is made to that certain document entitled "PACEMAKER
SURVEILLANCE SERVICES AGREEMENT" dated June 27, 1995, and further identified as
County Agreement No. H-204892 and any Amendments thereto (hereafter referred to as
"Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the parties hereto to amend said Agreement to extend the
term, and increase the maximum obligation, and to make other hereafter described changes; and

WHEREAS, Agreement provides that changes may be made in the form of a written
amendment which is formally approved and executed by the parties;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. This Amendment shall be effective on December 1, 2004.

2. The first subparagraph of Paragraph 1, TERM, shall be amended to read as follows:

"1. TERM: The term of this Agreement shall commence on July 1, 1995 and shall continue in full force and effect through December 31, 2005, with provision for a six-month automatic renewal, at the request of County, through June 30, 2006."

3. During the extended term, Contractor shall be compensated according to the same payment provisions and same rate(s) specified in Agreement for the 2001-2002 County fiscal year.

4. A third subparagraph of Paragraph 4, MAXIMUM OBLIGATION OF COUNTY, shall be added to read as follows:

"4. During the period December 1, 2004 through December 31, 2005, the maximum obligation of County for all services provided hereunder shall not exceed One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$117,000). During the renewal period, January 1, 2006 through June 30, 2006, the maximum obligation shall not exceed Fifty Four Thousand Dollars (\$54,000)."

5. Paragraph 31, CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM, shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"31. CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: Contractor acknowledges that County has established a goal of ensuring that all individuals who benefit financially from County

through contract are in compliance with their court-ordered child, family, and spousal support obligations in order to mitigate the economic burden otherwise imposed upon County and its taxpayers.

As required by County's Child Support Compliance Program (County Code Chapter 2.200) and without limiting Contractor's duty under this Agreement to comply with all applicable provisions of law, Contractor warrants that it is now in compliance and shall during the term of this Agreement maintain in compliance with employment and wage reporting requirements as required by the federal Social Security Act [(42 USC section 653(a)] and California Unemployment Insurance Code section 1088.55, and shall implement all lawfully served Wage and Earning Withholdings Orders or Child Support Services Department ("CSSD") Notices of Wage and Earnings Assignment for Child, Family, or Spousal Support, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 706.031 and Family Code section 5246(b)."

6. Paragraph 32, TERMINATION FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY TO MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM, shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"32. TERMINATION FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY TO MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM:
Failure of Contractor to maintain compliance with the requirements set forth in "Contractor's Warranty of Adherence to County's Child Support Compliance Program"

Paragraph immediately above, shall constitute default by Contractor under this Agreement. Without limiting the rights and remedies available to County under any other provision of this Agreement, failure of Contractor to cure such default within ninety (90) calendar days of written notice shall be grounds upon which County may terminate this contract pursuant to the "Termination for Default" Paragraph of this Agreement and pursue debarment of Contractor, pursuant to County Code Chapter 2.202."

7. Paragraph 39, CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY AND DEBARMENT, shall be revised to read as follows:

"39. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY AND DEBARMENT

A. Responsible Contractor

A responsible Contractor is a Contractor who has demonstrated the attribute of trustworthiness, as well as quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the contract. It is the County's policy to conduct business only with responsible Contractors.

B. Chapter 2.202 of the County Code

The Contractor is hereby notified that, in accordance with Chapter 2.202 of the County Code, if the County acquires information concerning the performance of the Contractor on this or other contracts which indicates that the Contractor is not responsible, the County may, in addition to other remedies provided in the Contract, debar the Contractor from bidding or proposing on, or

being awarded, and/or performing work on County contracts for a specified period of time not to exceed three (3) years, and terminate any or all existing Contracts the Contractor may have with the County.

C. Non-responsible Contractor

The County may debar a Contractor if the Board of Supervisors finds, in its discretion, that the Contractor has done any of the following: (1) violated a term of a contract with the County or a nonprofit corporation created by the County, (2) committed an act or omission which negatively reflects on the Contractor's quality, fitness or capacity to perform a contract with the County, any other public entity, or a nonprofit corporation created by the County, or engaged in a pattern or practice which negatively reflects on same, (3) committed an act or offense which indicates a lack of business integrity or business honesty, or (4) made or submitted a false claim against the County or any other public entity.

D. Contractor Hearing Board

If there is evidence that the Contractor may be subject to debarment, the Department will notify the Contractor in writing of the evidence which is the basis for the proposed debarment and will advise the Contractor of the scheduled date for a debarment hearing before the Contractor Hearing Board.

The Contractor Hearing Board will conduct a hearing where evidence on the proposed debarment is presented. The Contractor and/or the Contractor's representative shall be given an opportunity to submit evidence at that hearing. After the hearing, the Contractor Hearing Board shall prepare a tentative proposed decision, which shall contain a recommendation regarding whether the Contractor should be debarred, and, if so, the appropriate length of time of the debarment. The Contractor and the Department shall be provided an opportunity to object to the tentative proposed decision prior to its presentation to the Board of Supervisors.

After consideration of any objections, or if no objections are submitted, a record of the hearing, the proposed decision, and any other recommendation of the Contractor Hearing Board shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors shall have the right to modify, deny, or adopt the proposed decision and recommendation of the Contractor Hearing Board.

E. Subcontractors of Contractor

These terms shall also apply to Subcontractors of County Contractors."

8. Except for the changes set forth herein above, Agreement shall not be changed in any respect by this Amendment.

Agreement No. H-210760, and any Amendments thereto (hereafter referred to as "Agreement");
and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the parties hereto to amend said Agreement to extend the
term, and to make other hereafter described changes; and

WHEREAS, Agreement provides that changes may be made in the form of a written
amendment which is formally approved and executed by the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. This Amendment shall be effective on December 1, 2004.

2. Subparagraph A of Paragraph 1, TERM AND TERMINATION, shall be amended to read as follows:

"1. TERM AND TERMINATION:

A. The term of this Agreement shall commence on May 20, 1999, and shall continue in full force and effect through December 31, 2005, with provision for a six-month automatic renewal through June 30, 2006, at the request of County, unless earlier terminated, as provided in Paragraph 1.E. below."

3. Attachment 2, INTENSITY MODULATED RADIATION THERAPY CPT CODES, shall be added to Agreement. Any reference to Attachment 1 shall now also include reference to Attachment 2, attached hereto and included by reference.

4. During the extended term, Contractor shall be compensated according to the same payment provisions and same rate(s) specified in Agreement for the 2001-2002 County fiscal year.

5. Paragraph 24, CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM, shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"24. CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: Contractor acknowledges that County has established a goal of ensuring that all individuals who benefit financially from County through contract are in compliance with their court-ordered child, family, and spousal

support obligations in order to mitigate the economic burden otherwise imposed upon County and its taxpayers.

2. Subparagraph A of Paragraph 1, TERM AND TERMINATION, shall be amended to read as follows:

"1. TERM AND TERMINATION:

A. The term of this Agreement shall commence on May 20, 1999, and shall continue in full force and effect through December 31, 2005, with provision for a six-month automatic renewal through June 30, 2006 at the request of County, unless earlier terminated, as provided in Paragraph 1.E. below."

3. Attachment 2, INTENSITY MODULATED RADIATION THERAPY CPT CODES, shall be added to Agreement. Any reference to Attachment 1 shall now also include reference to Attachment 2, attached hereto and included by reference.

4. During the extended term, Contractor shall be compensated according to the same payment provisions and same rate(s) specified in Agreement for the 2001-2002 County fiscal year.

5. Paragraph 24, CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM, shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"24. CONTRACTOR'S WARRANTY OF ADHERENCE TO COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM: Contractor acknowledges that County has established a goal of ensuring that all individuals who benefit financially from County through contract are in compliance with their court-ordered child, family, and spousal

support obligations in order to mitigate the economic burden otherwise imposed upon County and its taxpayers.

As required by County's Child Support Compliance Program (County Code Chapter 2.200) and without limiting Contractor's duty under this Agreement to comply with all applicable provisions of law, Contractor warrants that it is now in compliance and shall during the term of this Agreement maintain in compliance with employment and wage reporting requirements as required by the federal Social Security Act [(42 USC section 653(a)] and California Unemployment Insurance Code section 1088.55, and shall implement all lawfully served Wage and Earnings Withholdings Orders or Child Support Services Department ("CSSD") Notices of Wage and Earnings Assignment for Child, Family, or Spousal Support, pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 706.031 and Family Code section 5246(b)."

6. Paragraph 25, TERMINATION FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY TO MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM, shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"25. TERMINATION FOR BREACH OF WARRANTY TO MAINTAIN COMPLIANCE WITH COUNTY'S CHILD SUPPORT COMPLIANCE PROGRAM:
Failure of Contractor to maintain compliance with the requirements set forth in "Contractor's Warranty of Adherence to County's Child Support Compliance Program" Paragraph immediately above, shall constitute default by Contractor under this

Agreement. Without limiting the rights and remedies available to County under any other provision of this Agreement failure of Contractor to cure such default within ninety (90)calendar days of written notice shall be grounds upon which County may terminate this contract pursuant to the "Termination for Default" Paragraph of this Agreement and pursue debarment of Contractor, pursuant to County Code Chapter 2.202."

7. Paragraph 28, CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY AND DEBARMENT, shall be revised to read as follows:

"28. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY AND DEBARMENT

A. Responsible Contractor

A responsible Contractor is a Contractor who has demonstrated the attribute of trustworthiness, as well as quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the contract. It is the County's policy to conduct business only with responsible Contractors.

B. Chapter 2.202 of the County Code

The Contractor is hereby notified that, in accordance with Chapter 2.202 of the County Code, if the County acquires information concerning the performance of the Contractor on this or other contracts which indicates that the Contractor is not responsible, the County may, in addition to other remedies provided in the Contract, debar the Contractor from bidding or proposing on, or being awarded, and/or performing work on County contracts

for a specified period of time not to exceed three (3) years, and terminate any or all existing Contracts the Contractor may have with the County.

C. Non-responsible Contractor

The County may debar a Contractor if the Board of Supervisors finds, in its discretion, that the Contractor has done any of the following: (1) violated a term of a contract with the County or a nonprofit corporation created by the County, (2) committed an act or omission which negatively reflects on the Contractor's quality, fitness or capacity to perform a contract with the County, any other public entity, or a nonprofit corporation created by the County, or engaged in a pattern or practice which negatively reflects on same, (3) committed an act or offense which indicates a lack of business integrity or business honesty, or (4) made or submitted a false claim against the County or any other public entity.

D. Contractor Hearing Board

If there is evidence that the Contractor may be subject to debarment, the Department will notify the Contractor in writing of the evidence which is the basis for the proposed debarment and will advise the Contractor of the scheduled date for a debarment hearing before the Contractor Hearing Board.

The Contractor Hearing Board will conduct a hearing where evidence on the proposed debarment is presented. The Contractor and/or the Contractor's

representative shall be given an opportunity to submit evidence at that hearing. After the hearing, the Contractor Hearing Board shall prepare a tentative proposed decision, which shall contain a recommendation regarding whether the Contractor should be debarred, and, if so, the appropriate length of time of the debarment. The Contractor and the Department shall be provided an opportunity to object to the tentative proposed decision prior to its presentation to the Board of Supervisors.

After consideration of any objections, or if no objections are submitted, a record of the hearing, the proposed decision, and any other recommendation of the Contractor Hearing Board shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors. The Board of Supervisors shall have the right to modify, deny, or adopt the proposed decision and recommendation of the Contractor Hearing Board.

E. Subcontractors of Contractor

These terms shall also apply to Subcontractors of County Contractors."

8. Except for the changes set forth herein above, Agreement shall not be changed in any respect by this Amendment.
