**TRANSPORTATION CORE SERVICE AREA
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS IN THE UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITIES
OF ATHENS/WESTMONT, EAST RANCHO DOMINGUEZ, FLORENCE/FIRESTONE, LENNOX,
WEST RANCHO DOMINGUEZ, AND WILLOWBROOK
(SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 2)
(3 VOTES)**

SUBJECT

Public Works is seeking Board approval to implement traffic regulations to support traffic safety and enhance traffic flow in the unincorporated communities of Athens/Westmont, East Rancho Dominguez, Florence/Firestone, Lennox, West Rancho Dominguez, and Willowbrook.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD:

1. Find that adopting and/or rescinding traffic regulation orders and posting the corresponding regulatory and advisory signage are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
2. Adopt a traffic regulation order requiring northbound traffic on Wilton Place to stop at its intersection with 115th Street, establishing all-way stop control in the unincorporated community of Athens/Westmont.
3. Adopt a traffic regulation order establishing a disabled persons' parking zone on the south side of 106th Street between a point 196 feet and a point 216 feet west of Budlong Avenue in the unincorporated community of Athens/Westmont.

4. Adopt a traffic regulation order establishing a disabled persons' parking zone on the north side of 101st Street between a point 194 feet and a point 214 feet west of Vermont Avenue in the unincorporated community of Athens/Westmont.
5. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting parking for a period longer than 30 minutes, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., except Saturdays and Sundays, on the south side of East Rose Street between a point 22 feet west and a point 82 feet west of Atlantic Avenue in the unincorporated community of East Rancho Dominguez.
6. Adopt a traffic regulation order establishing a disabled persons' parking zone on the north side of 68th Street between a point 115 feet and a point 135 feet west of Converse Avenue in the unincorporated community of Florence/Firestone.
7. Adopt a traffic regulation order requiring eastbound and westbound traffic on Lennox Boulevard to stop at its intersection with Condon Avenue, establishing all-way stop control in the unincorporated community of Lennox.
8. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting stopping at any time on the east side of Figueroa Street between a point 139 feet to a point 446 feet south of Compton Boulevard in the unincorporated community of West Rancho Dominguez.
9. Rescind a traffic regulation order establishing a disabled persons' parking zone on the west side of South Northwood Avenue between a point 285 feet south and a point 305 feet south of East 139th Street in unincorporated community of Willowbrook, as established on April 18, 2017.
10. Adopt a traffic regulation order requiring eastbound and westbound traffic on 118th Street to stop at its intersection with Success Avenue, establishing all-way stop control in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.
11. Adopt a traffic regulation order establishing a stop control for northbound and southbound traffic on Grandee Avenue at its intersection with 122nd Street in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.
12. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting overnight parking from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the north and south sides of 132nd Street between Broadway Street and its easterly terminus in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.
13. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting parking from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the north and south sides of 134th Street between Broadway Street and its easterly terminus in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.
14. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting parking from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the north and south sides of 131st Street between Broadway Street and Main Street in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.
15. Adopt a traffic regulation order prohibiting parking from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. on the east and west sides of Spring Street between El Segundo Boulevard and 131st Street in the unincorporated community of Willowbrook.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The purpose of the recommended actions is to support traffic safety, enhance traffic flow, and provide adequate parking for disabled persons. Requests for these traffic regulations were generated by residents or community groups. The affected areas are indicated on the enclosed maps (Attachments B, C, D, E, F, and G).

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

These recommendations support the County Strategic Plan: Strategy II.3, Make Environmental Sustainability our Daily Reality. The recommended actions support a clean, flexible, and integrated Multi-Modal Transportation System that improves mobility and traffic safety.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

There will be no impact to the County General Fund. Sufficient funds are included in the Road Fund Fiscal Year 2020-21 Budget to cover the minor costs of removing and installing the necessary signs and markings.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

The California Vehicle Code authorizes the Board to implement these traffic regulations, which are required prior to enforcement by the California Highway Patrol and the Sheriff's Department.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

The establishment of these regulations, including the installation of related traffic control devices required to notify the motoring public is categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines and Class I(x) 7 of the Environmental Reporting Procedures and Guidelines approved by the Board on November 17, 1987.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

Implementation of these traffic controls will have a positive impact by enhancing traffic flow and safety and providing parking for disabled persons. Upon the Board's approval of these traffic regulations, the corresponding signs and markings will be installed within 12 weeks.

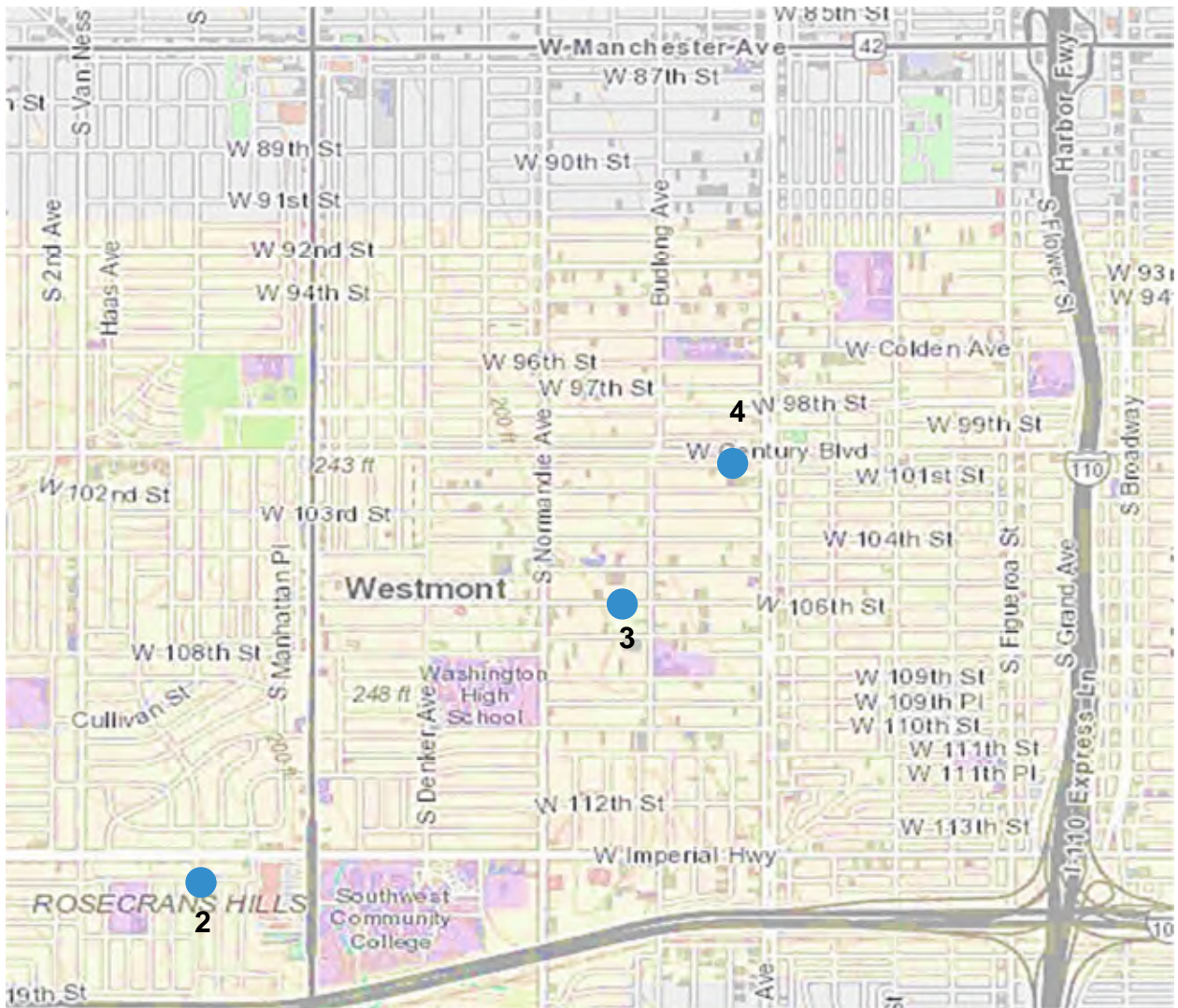

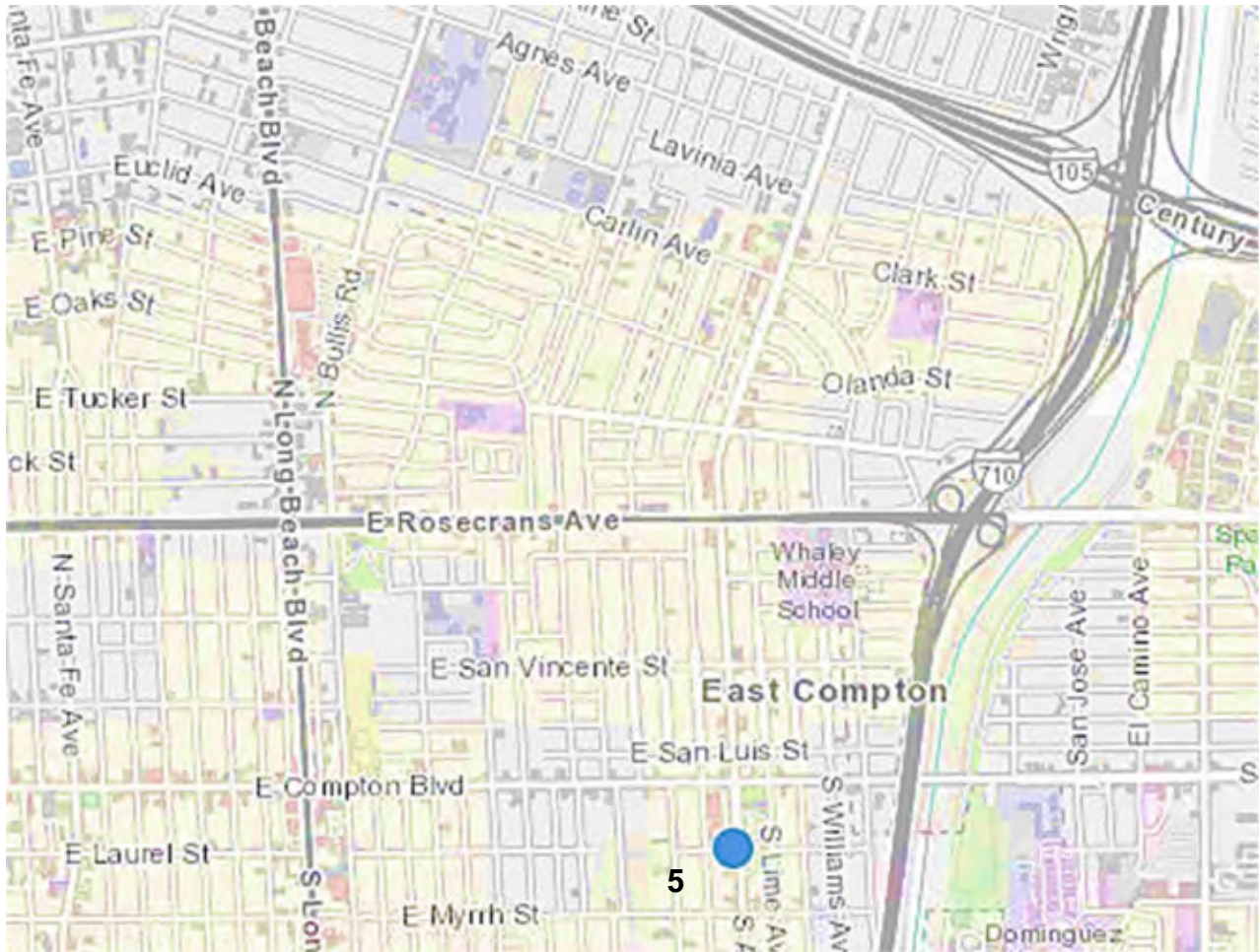

SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 2**



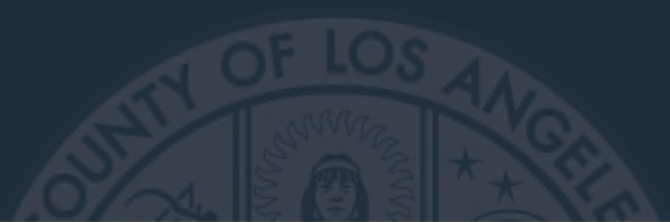

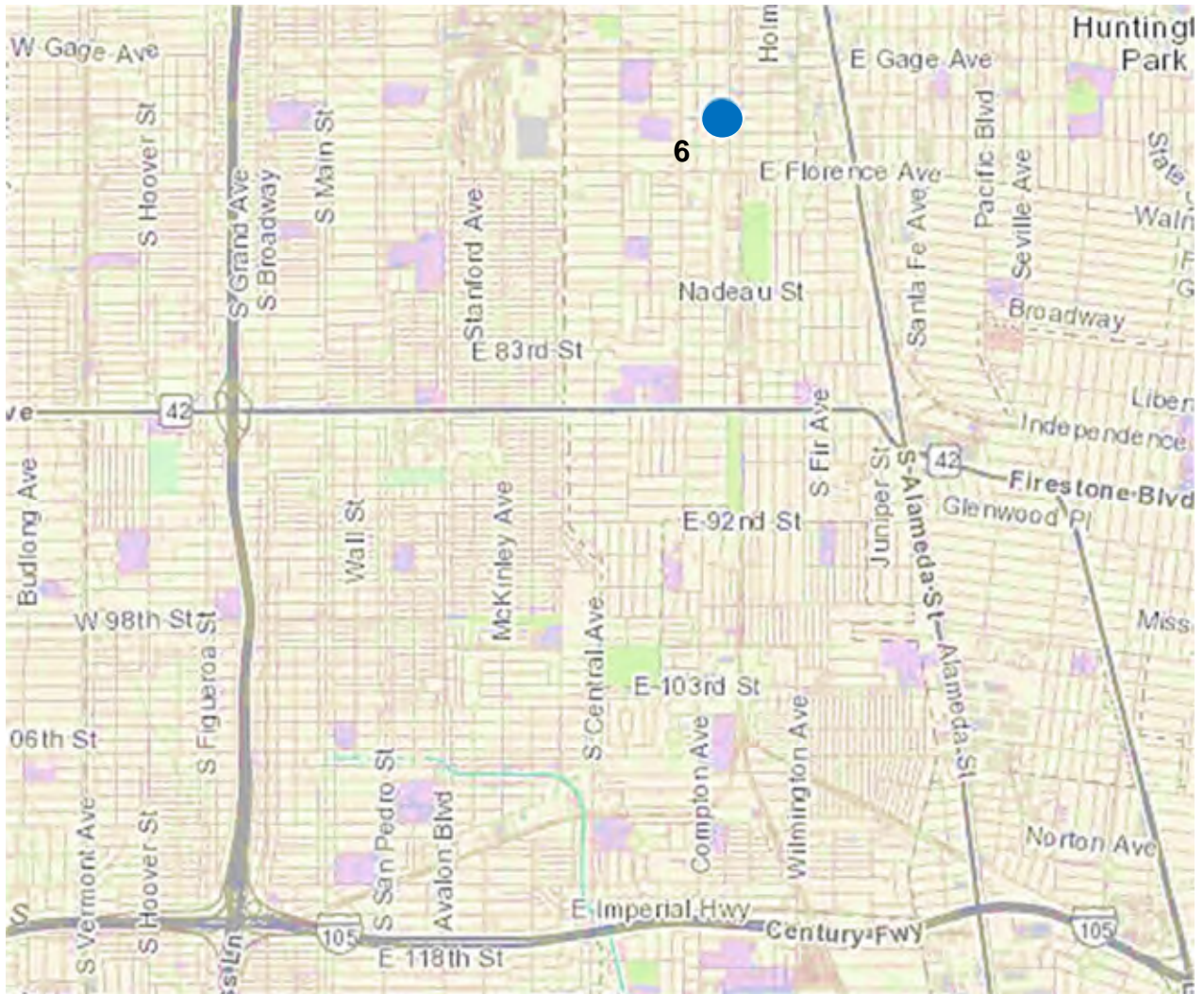

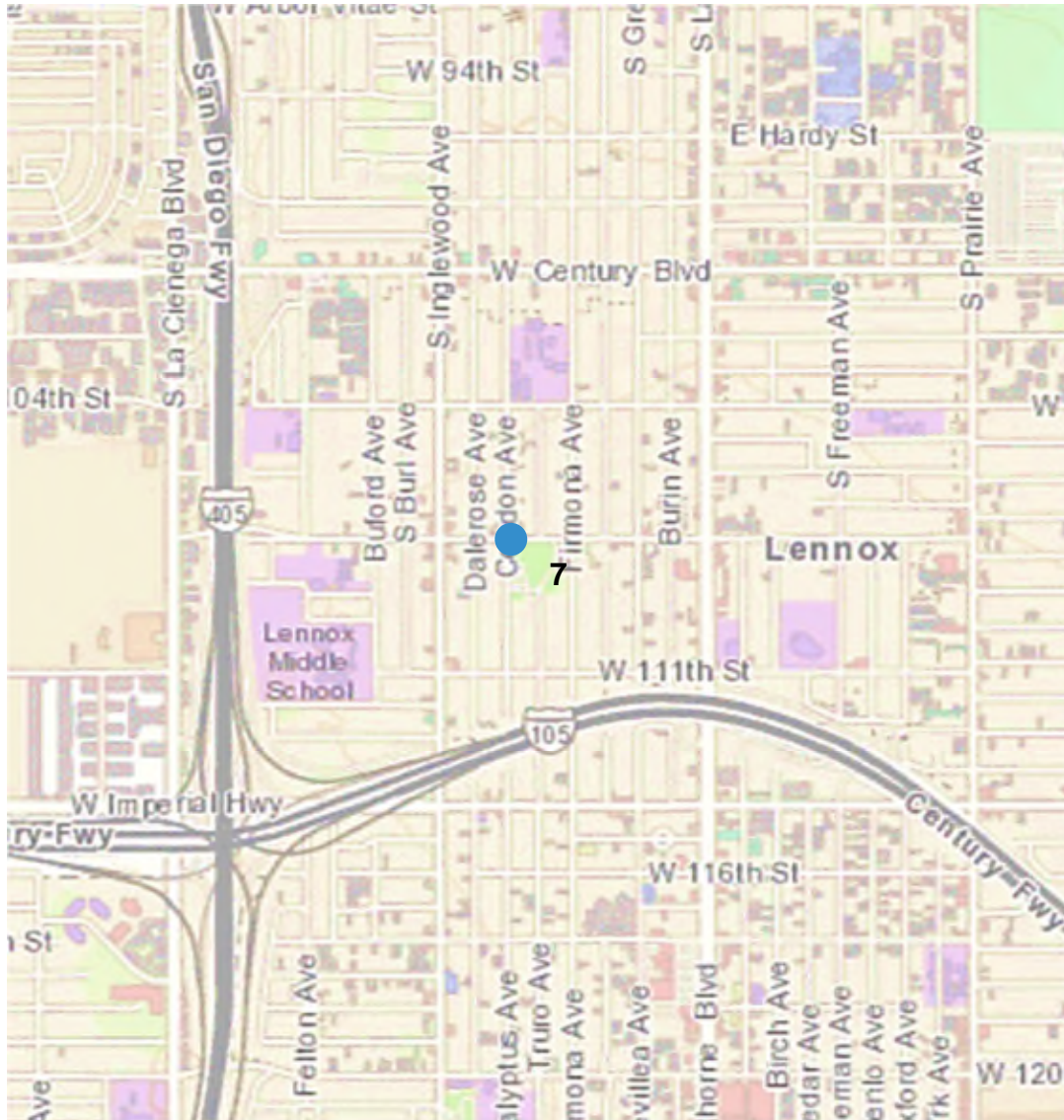

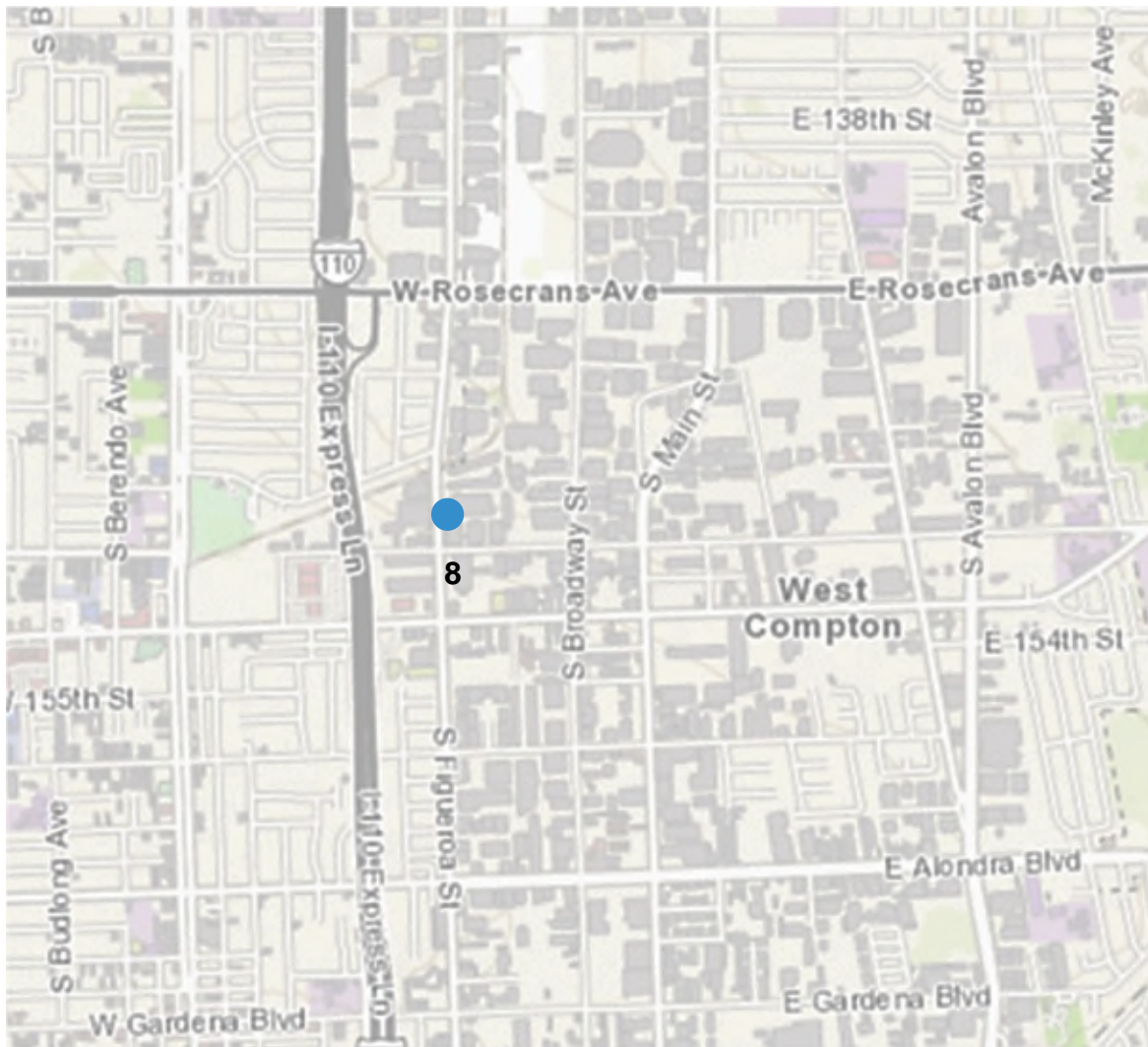

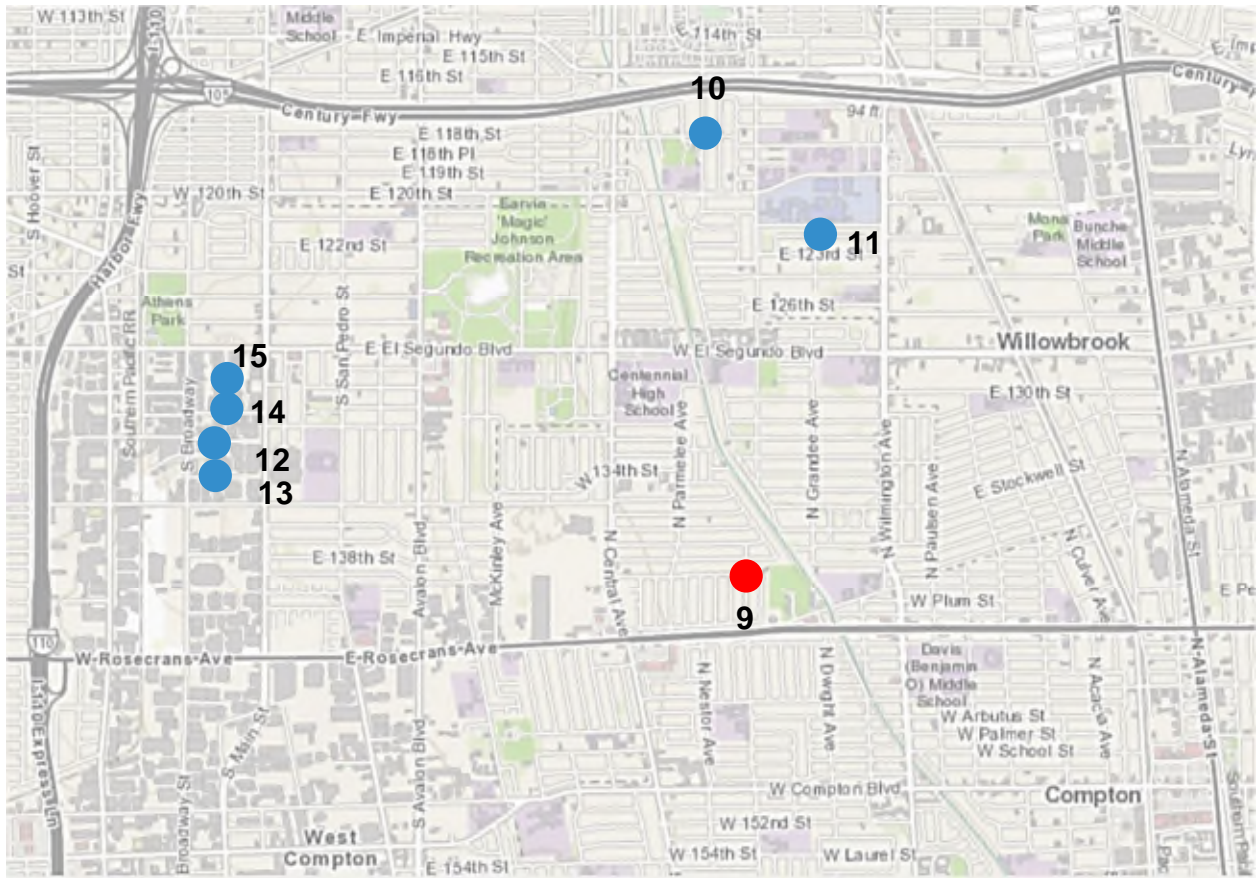
