BOYS AND GIRLS CLUB OF PASADENA – MACKENZIE-SCOTT CLUBHOUSE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The mission of the Boys and Girls Club of Pasadena (Club) is to enable children and youth in the community, especially those need them the most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, healthy, and responsible citizens. The Club provides a safe, supportive, and enriching environment for the children of Pasadena and surrounding areas since its founding in 1937.

The Club changes the trajectory of kids' lives through programs and activities focused on academic success, healthy lifestyles, and good character development and leadership. The weekly, year-round program has provided more than 250,000 community children with a safe fun, and nurturing place to call their own. The club owns and operates two clubhouse facilities in Pasadena, the Slavik Clubhouse in east Pasadena and the Mackenzie-Scott Clubhouse in northwest Pasadena. Both facilities have been in continuous operation for nearly fifty years.

The Club has requested \$135,000 for a renovation project at the Mackenzie-Scott Clubhouse. The proposed project involves interior renovations to the clubhouse to address safety issues and to enhance and upgrade the interior appearance by updating portions of the electrical systems, replace aging and worn flooring and wall base, re-surface the gym walls, repair and/or replace ceiling tiles and safety glass and paint.

Therefore, the recommendation is to allocate \$135,000 in Excess Funds available to the Fifth Supervisorial District for this Project.

Authorize the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation, or her designee, in her capacity as Director of the Los Angeles County Regional Park and Open Space District, to award grants when applicable conditions have been met, and to administer the grants as of the date of award and pursuant to guidelines in the Procedural Guide for Specified, Per Parcel, and Excess Funds Projects; otherwise funds shall remain in the Excess Funds account.
