Reward Reestablishment in the Homicide Investigation of Jacquarius “Jay” Quinn

On Sunday, November 6, 2016, at approximately 8:30 p.m., Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Department (LASD) deputies were dispatched to the 2300 block of Old Harold Road in the City of Palmdale. 17-year-old Jacquarius “Jay” Quinn was found lying on the middle of the roadway, unconscious and suffering from a gunshot wound to his upper torso. Victim Quinn was transported to an area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

During the investigation, LASD investigators learned that Victim Quinn had returned home after dining out with his family and was subsequently found on the roadway by witnesses who stopped and called for aid.

At the time of his murder, Victim Quinn was an 11th grade student at R. Rex Parris High School in the City of Palmdale. Victim Quinn is survived by his parents, siblings and grandmother. The families, who have been helpful during the investigation and remain in contact with the investigators, are devastated by this senseless tragedy.

The \$10,000 reward offer approved by this Board on November 13, 2018, was extended on February 5, 2019; reward amount increased to \$20,000 on February 26, 2019, extended on August 6, 2019 and February 4, 2020 and expired on August 3, 2020. To date, LASD investigators have received few tips and are actively working the case. LASD investigators believe the extension of this reward will encourage witnesses to come forward and provide information to this investigation. Any individuals with information about this crime are urged to contact LASD's Homicide Bureau of Crime Stoppers.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reestablish the previously offered reward in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for the heinous murder of Jacquarius "Jay" Quinn.
