Establish the Reward Offer in the Murder of Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez

On Friday, September 24, 2021, at approximately 11:51 p.m., 16-year-old Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez had just left a gathering with some friends near the 1900 block of east Pine Street in the city of Compton. While walking to his car with his friends, a large fight started in the middle of the street. During the altercation, a suspect pulled out a firearm and shot Mr. Trujillo Ramirez. Mr. Trujillo Ramirez suffered a gunshot wound to the upper torso and died at the scene. There is limited suspect information at this time.

Mr. Trujillo Ramirez was a junior at Narbonne High School at the time of his death. He was a good student who enjoyed spending time with family and friends. Additionally, he was a member of the Reserve Officers' Training Corps.

Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department investigators believe a reward would bring attention to the case and encourage witnesses that might have seen and/or know the identity of the suspect(s) to come forward and bring justice to the victim and his family.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Establish the offer of a reward in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of 16-year-old Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez who was shot and killed on the 1900 block of east Pine Street in the city of Compton on September 24, 2021, at approximately 11:51
