**QUITCLAIM OF STORM DRAIN EASEMENT
TRACT NO. 45645
PRIVATE DRAIN NO. 2537 - PARCEL 2EX
VICINITY OF CASTAIC JUNCTION
SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 5
3 VOTES**

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD ACTING AS THE GOVERNING BODY
OF THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT:**

1. Find this Quitclaim of Easement to be categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
2. Declare the Los Angeles County Flood Control District's (LACFCD) easement in Exhibit A as an excess easement.
3. Authorize the quitclaim of easement to the underlying fee owners, Alan and Deborah Cusick.
4. Instruct the Chair to execute the enclosed Quitclaim of Easement document and authorize delivery to the grantee.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

The easement that was dedicated to the LACFCD as described in Exhibit A is no longer required. Due to the LACFCD requests, revised plans for Private Drain No. 2537 have been reviewed and approved; therefore, the original easement is now in excess. This action will provide for the quitclaim of the excess easement back to the underlying property owners as described in Exhibit A.



DESCRIPTION

PARCEL NO. 2EX (Quitclaim of easement)

That portion of Lot 12 of Tract No. 45645, as shown on map filed in Book 1264, pages 56 to 66, inclusive of Maps, in the office of the Recorder of the County of Los Angeles, designated as "  EASEMENT, TO THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT FOR FLOOD CONTROL PURPOSES," lying within the following described boundaries:

Commencing at the northeasterly corner of said Lot 12; thence South 12°55'30" East 119.82 feet along the easterly line of said lot to an angle point of above mentioned flood control easement, said angle point also being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence along the boundary of said easement the following courses: South 12°40'37" West 24.17 feet, South 43°27'04" West 46.69 feet; South 76°40'31" West 54.70 feet; South 12°00'08" East 120.46 feet to the southerly line of said lot; thence North 77°59'52" East 7.23 feet along said southerly line; thence leaving said southerly line North 12°00'08" West 44.57 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concave to the southeast and having a radius of 45.03 feet; thence northerly and northeasterly along said curve through a central angle of 67°32'36" an arc length of

53.08 feet to the beginning of a reverse curve concave to the northwest and having a radius of 149.22 feet; thence northeasterly along said last mentioned curve through a central angle of $19^{\circ}49'38''$ an arc length of 51.64 feet to the beginning of a compound curve concave to the west and having a radius of 77.08 feet; thence northerly along said last mentioned curve through a central angle of $42^{\circ}21'11''$ an arc length of 56.97 feet to the said easterly line of Lot 12; thence along said easterly line North $12^{\circ}55'30''$ West 6.64 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING.
