Extend and Increase the Reward Offer in the Murder of Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez

On Friday, September 24, 2021, at approximately 11:51 p.m., 16-year-old Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez had just left a gathering with some friends near the 1900 block of east Pine Street in the city of Compton. While walking to his car with his friends, a large fight started in the middle of the street. During the altercation, a suspect pulled out a firearm and shot Mr. Trujillo Ramirez. Mr. Trujillo Ramirez suffered a gunshot wound to the upper torso and died at the scene. There is limited suspect information at this time.

Mr. Trujillo Ramirez was a junior at Narbonne High School at the time of his death. He was a good student who enjoyed spending time with family and friends. Additionally, he was a member of the Reserve Officers' Training Corps.

The Board of Supervisors established this reward on January 25, 2022. It is due to expire on April 24, 2022 and needs to be extended. Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department investigators believe a reward would bring attention to the case and encourage witnesses that might have seen and/or know the identity of the suspect(s) to come forward and bring justice to the victim and his family.

I THEREFORE MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Extend and increase the offer of a reward in the amount of \$20,000 in exchange for information leading to the apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the heinous death of 16-year-old Ricardo Trujillo Ramirez who was shot and killed on the 1900 block of east Pine Street in the city of Compton on September 24, 2021, at
