At its meeting held February 22, 2005, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Burke made the following statement:

“On Friday March 18, 2005, our Chief Administrative Officer, David E. Janssen, and the American Society for Public Administration, Los Angeles (LA ASPA) Metropolitan chapter, are co-hosting a special presentation by State Legislative Analyst Elizabeth Hill for LA ASPA members and other interested Los Angeles County public administrators. Ms. Hill’s presentation is entitled, ‘The Financial Outlook for the State of California,’ and will be conducted in our Board’s chambers live via teleconference from Sacramento. The State Legislative Analyst is the nonpartisan fiscal advisor to both houses of the State Legislature.

“Ms. Hill’s presentation will provide information on the Governor’s 2005-06 proposed budget and related financial ballot measures proposed as a part of the Governor’s budget proposal. This information is very timely and very relevant to all local agencies and public administrators in the Los Angeles County region.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried, the Board waived parking fees for 100 cars in amount not to exceed \$1,700.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance, at the Music Center garage for attendees of the presentation on ‘The Financial Outlook for the State of California’ by State Legislative Analyst Elizabeth Hill, to be held at the Board of Supervisors’ Hearing Room on March 18, 2005.
