RE-ESTABLISHING REWARD

On September 2, 2004, thirty-year-old Sharon Anne Santos was discovered dead in the trunk of her black Honda Accord in Chinatown after being reported missing for two weeks. Sharon was a Burbank resident and an employee of Warner Bros. who was last seen leaving work on the evening of August 17.

Investigators of the Burbank Police Department are seeking the assistance of anyone who may have information that could aid their investigation.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors re-establish the reward in the amount of \$10,000 in return for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of Sharon Anne Santos.
