At its meeting held May 10, 2005, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Molina made the following statement:

“The Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Local 660 of Los Angeles County is sponsoring the 12th Annual ‘Keep L.A. Running’ 5K Walk/Run, 10K Run and Fun Bike Cruise, on Sunday, July 10, 2005 at the Los Angeles Coliseum. The ‘Keep Los Angeles Running’ Event will benefit the SEIU/Local 660, L.A. County/Special Districts Employees Disaster Relief Fund; the Rosa Parks Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at Martin Luther King, Jr./Drew Medical Center; the Pediatric Oncology Service at the Women’s and Children’s Hospital of LAC+USC Medical Center; and the American Cancer Society. SEIU has requested assistance in disseminating information of promotional materials with employees pay warrant in May and June of 2005.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Molina, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried, the Board took the following actions:

1. Proclaimed July 10, 2005 as “Keep L.A. Running Day” throughout Los Angeles County;
2. Instructed the Chief Administrative Officer and the Director of Personnel to provide the necessary support, including allowing dissemination of event information through County e-mail, payroll warrants, and other County communication systems;

3. Instructed the Executive Officer of the Board to:
 - Notify all County departments and the County parking contractor to grant all access to SEIU/Local 660 for the purpose of promoting the Union's sponsorship of the 12th Annual "Keep L.A. Running" 5K/10K Run/Walk and Fun Bike Cruise, to be held at the Los Angeles Coliseum on July 10, 2005; and
 - Coordinate, through its Auxiliary Services Division, Charitable Giving Section, efforts with SEIU as they did with the March of Dimes Campaign; and
4. Encouraged all County employees to participate in this event.
