At its meeting held May 24, 2005, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Molina made the following statement:

“For the last thirteen years the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and the County Commission on Disabilities have cosponsored the Annual Access Awards Luncheon on the Third Wednesday in October. The purpose of the luncheon is to recognize individuals, corporate and public entities that have made outstanding contributions and/or demonstrated leadership and commitment toward encouraging, facilitating or promoting equality for persons with disabilities, as well as provide a venue for disabled persons to network with agencies and providers that service the disability community. This year the Awards Luncheon will be held on Wednesday, October 19, 2005 and the County Commission on Disabilities has again asked the Board of Supervisors to be a partner for this event.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Molina seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried (Supervisors Burke and Yaroslavsky being absent), the Board took the following actions:

1. Designated October 2005 as “Disability Awareness Month;”
2. Agreed to cosponsor, along with the Los Angeles County Commission on Disabilities, the 14th Annual Access Awards Luncheon, to be held October 19, 2005;
3. Requested the Music Center to waive rental fees in amount of \$800.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for use of the Grand Hall at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion;

5. Instructed related County departments to work with the Commission to ensure effective coordination of activities for the luncheon.
