At its meeting held August 30, 2005, the Board took the following action:

86-A

Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“On Thursday, August 25, 2005, the California Public Utilities Commission (PUC) voted to enact an overlay of the 310 area code with a new 424 area code. This decision was based on significantly outdated information and should not have occurred without a current Telephone Utilization Study being performed.

“Because it appears the PUC’s decision is inconsistent with California law and poses serious concerns on the impact to the residents and business owners living within the 310 area code, the Board of Supervisors should review the impact of the PUC action and evaluate our options.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried (Supervisor Molina being absent), the Chief Administrative Officer and County Counsel were instructed to investigate, and report back within 14 days, on courses of action available to the Board, including possible litigation, to respond to the California Public Utilities Commission’s vote to create an overlay of the 310 area code.
