MOTION BY SUPERVISOR ZEV YAROSLAVSKY

JANUARY 17, 2006

On October 18, 2005, the Board instructed the Chief Administrative Office to negotiate and execute a sublease for an unimproved parcel of land within the Consolidated Fire Protection District (Fire District) Pacoima Complex with Communities In Schools, Inc. (CIS), a 501 (3) (c) non-profit corporation, for the purpose of establishing a Job Training Center (Center) in the San Fernando Valley for at-risk and probation youths.

In addition to one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) previously appropriated for this project from the Third Supervisorial District Anti-Gang Strategies Program, the Board approved an additional appropriation of \$300,000 fully funded by Probation Department FY 2004-05 savings. As part of its efforts to secure the additional funding necessary to complete construction of the facility that will house the Center, CIS has applied for a \$200,000 grant from the City of Los Angeles Community Redevelopment Agency (Agency). Because the grant funds will be spent on property that is not owned by the City, or the Agency, applicable law requires that this Board make a finding that no other reasonable funding sources are available for the project.
