At its meeting held January 31, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Yaroslavsky made the following statement:

“The Los Angeles Unified School District will be holding a memorial service for John Liechty, Associate Superintendent of the Extended Day Programs, at the Walt Disney Concert Hall on February 6, 2006.

“John was a passionate advocate for all youngsters with a special compassion for ‘at-risk youth.’ In 2000, he eagerly accepted the offer to head the after-school program and created the ‘Beyond the Bell’ Branch, which is presently a \$250 million dollar a year program providing academic interventions, before and after-school programs, and summer school/intersession programs. ‘Beyond the Bell’ has become a nationally recognized model for Extended Day Programs.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Yaroslavsky, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried, the Board requested the Music Center to waive fees in amount of \$8,500.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for use of the auditorium and BP Hall at the Walt Disney Concert Hall, for the Los Angeles Unified School District’s memorial service for John Liechty, Associate Superintendent of the Extended Day Programs, to be held February 6, 2006.
