Chill is an intervention program for underprivileged and at-risk, inner-city kids from the Los Angeles area. Chill brings kids between the ages of 10 to 18 out of the city once a week for six weeks and provides them with everything they need to learn to snowboard: lift tickets, instruction, bus transportation and head-to-toe gear. This nonprofit organization works through agencies that services disadvantage kids on probation, in foster care, at-risk of drop-out, gangs. These are all kids who would never otherwise have this opportunity.

On March 4, 2006, the Los Angeles Chill program hosted a get-together at Marina "Mother's " Beach for the kids to celebrate their successful completion of the Chill program.
