At its meeting held February 28, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“On Saturday, February 25, 2006, at approximately 10:30 p.m., there was a racially-motivated disturbance involving Hispanic and African-American minors at Challenger – Camp McNair. Staff was able to respond and quickly stop the fighting. Thirty minors have been sent to the Special Housing Unit (SHU) and the camp was on lock down status on Sunday with the exception of parent visits. Disturbances or youth-on-youth violence appear to be on the rise in the Probation camps and halls. These disturbances are a safety concern for the minors and Probation staff.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Molina, unanimously carried, the Chief Probation Officer was directed to provide the Board a report within 15 days relative to youth-on-youth violence and other disturbances in the camps and halls, including an assessment of the causes leading to the increase in the number of incidents and the Department's actions, proposed or implemented, to prevent these incidents from occurring.
