At its meeting held February 28, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Burke made the following statement:

“On December 20, 2005, the Board of Supervisors approved a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of Demariya Grant. The reward offer will expire on March 20, 2006.

“On Thursday, December 15, 2005, at approximately 6:30 p.m. 9-year-old Demariya Grant was the victim of a fatal hit and run.

“The female driver struck Demariya Grant in a late model 70’s or 80’s red Lincoln or Ford, and was crossing Rodeo Boulevard east of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried, the Board extended the \$5,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the fatal hit and run of 9-year-old Demariya Grant, who was crossing Rodeo Boulevard east of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, on Thursday, December 15, 2005 at approximately 6:30 p.m.

**NOTICE OF \$5,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has extended a \$5,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the fatal hit and run of 9-year-old Demariya Grant, who was crossing Rodeo Boulevard east of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, on Thursday, December 15, 2005 at approximately 6:30 p.m.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Shawn Williams of the Los Angeles Police Department at (323) 290-6063 and refer to Report No. 050337421.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than June 18, 2006. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than August 17, 2006.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$5,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than August 17, 2006 with the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Demariya Grant Reward Fund.
