Supervisor Yaroslavsky made the following statement:

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Yaroslavsky, seconded by Supervisor Burke, unanimously carried (Supervisors Molina and Antonovich being absent), the Board proclaimed May 19, 2006 as "NASCAR Day" throughout Los Angeles County, celebrating the third anniversary of the one-day celebration of the NASCAR spirit and encouraging all Angelenos to honor the members of the NASCAR Foundation family for their many contributions that benefit a wide variety of people and causes.
