At its meeting held May 30, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“On Sunday, June 20, 2004, Richard Betts and William Betts were shot to death in the 3200 block of White Cloud Drive, Hacienda Heights. A reward was previously offered on this case and it is set to expire June 3, 2006. Sheriff’s Homicide Bureau detectives are still actively investigating this murder case and feel that the offering of a reward would help in their attempt to identify and apprehend the suspect(s) in this case.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried (Supervisors Molina and Yaroslavsky being absent), the Board extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the deaths of Richard and William Betts, who were shot in the 3200 block of White Cloud Dr., in the City of Hacienda Heights on Sunday, June 20, 2004.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the deaths of Richard and William Betts, who were shot in the 3200 block of White Cloud Dr., in the City of Hacienda Heights on Sunday, June 20, 2004.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Jeff Leslie at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Homicide Bureau at (323) 890-5500 and refer to Report No. 005-07918-2922-011.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than September 1, 2006. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than October 31, 2006.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than October 31, 2006 with the Executive Officer of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Richard and William Betts Reward Fund.
