

MOTION BY SUPERVISOR GLORIA MOLINA

June 13, 2006

On December 6, 2005, Fermin Cardenas, a 60-year-old man, was shot and killed on his way to his morning walk at Santa Fe Dam.

To date, the perpetrator responsible for this heinous crime is still at-large. On March 14, 2006, I moved that the Board of Supervisors approve a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person responsible for the death of Fermin Cardenas. Since that time, the reward has expired.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors approve the reestablishment of this \$10,000 reward, in order to fulfill our commitment to justice.
